There should not be enough southerly component to the wind to complicate the burn out in the SE corner or create a problem from south of the highway in the SW, but the possibilities should be considered.</p> <p><b>Structure:</b> Okefenokee administrative site is not likely to be impacted by fire spread during this operational period...</p> <p><b>IA:</b> Expect moderate to extreme fire behavior with fires establishing quickly.</p>
