3. Provide accurate cost accountability and documentation of expenditures for the duration of the incident.
4. Develop and maintain coordination with local fire departments, local EOC directors, GEMA, other IMT's deployed in the area, GOAL, and private industry.
5. Provide support on fires as requested by Georgia GFC District 8 and District 10.
6. Conduct all incident activities in a manner free of discrimination, harassment, and inappropriate behavior.
7. Keep the Sweat Farm Road, Kneeknocker, and Roundabout fires contained within the current established perimeters.
8. Assist with identifying and mitigating Emergency & Temporary Repairs.

WEATHER DISCUSSION: An upper level ridge and dry airmass will remain over the area today, bringing even warmer and drier weather and no chance for rain. Fire activity is mostly expected in Divisions WI & WH where hot spots were noted yesterday, along with Divisions WE, WF, WS, & WG along previous burnout lines. Pockets of unburned fuels will continue to burn along with the possibility of reburn in many areas.

Winds SW 3-5 in AM, rotating to the NW 5-10 with gusts to 15mph, becoming SE with gusts 15 mph.

RH – 32% to 35% / Temp - 99 to 100

Rates of Spread –13 to 34 ft/min / Flame lengths – 4’ to 13’

Probability of Ignition: 50% / KBDI: 352

Mixing heights today will push 8000’

SAFTEY: Winds increasing and changing directions throughout the day will change the fire’s direction.

Ensure the lines will hold with different wind directions pushing the line.

Watch Out for **Snags!!!**. Snags in the area continue to fall. If you must work in an area with Snags **Post a Lookout**.

Temperature is rising nearing 100 degrees, Drink plenty of water and remember the 4 to 1 ratio of water and sports drinks. Use **Sun Screen** to protect your skin from sun Burn, and take frequent breaks.

Always **obey local traffic laws!** Use head lights on the fire scene. Watch for other drivers. Use caution in congested areas. **Give driving your full attention!** Ensure daily maintenance checks are performed on all equipment and service as needed.

Traveling home? Follow the Travel Regulations in the NWCG Fire Business Handbook and your Agency Policies regarding travel.

Insure that Instructions are clear and understood.

Communication Responsibilities

All firefighters have five communication responsibilities:

- Brief others as needed
- Debrief your actions
- Communicate hazards to others
- Acknowledge messages
- Ask if you don't know

In addition, all leaders of firefighters have the responsibility to provide complete briefings that include a clearly stated "Leaders Intent."

- Task = What is to be done
- Purpose = Why it is to be done
- End State = How it should look when done
