
Human Resource Message

WEATHER DISCUSSION: Disturbances rotating through an upper level trough should combine with daytime heating and a relatively moist airmass to produce scattered showers and thunderstorms today and again on Thursday. In addition, afternoon seabreezes should help focus shower and thunderstorm chances through Friday. However, the trough will lift out of the area to end the week, with an upper level ridge building back in for the weekend. This should result in hot, humid weather, with minimal chances for precipitation.

The Main Concern is: Lighting potential.

TODAY'S FIRE BEHAVIOR WILL BE LOW

Overall, fire behavior will be low today after receiving 1 + inches of rain. Divisions WW, WY, WX, WF, WS &WG where burnout operations took place showed cooler on IR flight. Direct attack with Dozer/Tractor Plows will be effective today and with production constraints.

Ease 3-5 mph through 1000, increasing with gust to 15mph. When Sea-breeze passes @1800 winds will become more SE.

RH - 42% to 45% / Temp - 85 to 88

Rates of Spread – Fuel Model 4 (heavy shrub) ROS - 13 – 30 ft/min / Flame lengths – 5' to 13' Fuel Model 7 (Southern Rough) ROS - 13 to 20 ft/min / Flame lengths - 4' to 6'

Weather – There is a chance of thunder storms today with possibility of lighting. Use the 30/30 rule.

Complacency – Don't get complacent, be aware of your surroundings. Look up, look down, look all around.

Driving - Use caution while driving on wet roads. Watch for standing water on roadway it could cause you to hydroplane. Do not cross flooded roads, the road may be washed out.

Winch Operations – Wet roads means stuck trucks, use caution and proper winch operations

Unfamiliar with assigned area – If you get a new assignment, become familiar with your area. Know where your safety zones and escape routes are. Try to tie in with the person you are relieving, to find out as much information about the area as possible.

Winch Safety

Winching can be dangerous. There are certain things That should be done and followed, not only for your Safety, but for the safety of others and the environment.

Check your cable, look for frays and kinks in the cable.

Wear your PPE: gloves, eye protection, and hardhat.

Use winch blanket or heavy coat to keep the cable from Flying back towards the operator.

Some items that can help with winch operation: Snatch Blocks will double your pulling power, Tree straps will Help protect the trees from girdling.






