### Weather Summary (See Today's Detailed Weather Forecast in the IAP):

Once again the overnight RH recovery had no meaningful impact to fuel moistures. With today's forecasted weather, the windspeeds start out favorably, CALM in early AM. They then increase E 5 -10 mph by 1100hrs, and then become E to SE 8 -12 mph w/ G to 18 mph. The Air Temp & RH will again be hot & dry. Cloud Cover will not provide any meaningful positive impact. FB will not be capped today. There is a concern that requires further review as there can be weather influences working above us. The Haines is 5 & the mixing height has bumped higher. These can be indicators that the potential for extreme fire behavior may be at a higher level than expected. This will receive further review and Operations will be advised immediately.

<u>General Fire Behavior:</u> Yesterday, the fire perimeter expanded as forecasted. GIS mapping verified the Rate of Spread. Division Alpha's breakover spread at 45 chains per hour. The spot fire went from Swamp Perimeter Rd to Mose Rd, a distance of 1.1 miles in 2 hours 20 minutes. With **Today's probability of ignition at 80**, new fire starts will ignite easily and spread rapidly. The Alpha breakover spread through young 6-ft pine plantation and displayed 10 to 12 ft flame lengths while fire in 60-ft pine stand with 6ft tall shrubs displayed flames & heat that ignited the crowns. This breakover spread rapidly through these two critical fuel types (bay type drain and pine plantation with an understory southern rough).

These fuels have the greatest reburn potential, torching ability, and can produce flame lengths that can contribute to spotting up to ¼ mile. They afford the best opportunity for fire escapes and both can support crown fire runs. Young pine plantations that are 5 to 8 ft tall burn as a brush fuel model. This fuel type achieves the fastest rates of spread. Below is the expected fire behavior for respective fuel models. They can assist in time distance planning. These were accurate for runs yesterday.

<u>All Fires:</u> Yesterday's weather has made the forest fuels drier yet. All containment lines on all fires need to be reviewed for threat of sleepers or reburn potential.

**Air Operations:** Moderate inversion & the smoke can limit aircraft visibility in the morning. Smoke production is expected & very poor visibility will be in the AM as winds will be CALM. All western fire perimeters remain impacted by smoke production.

**Safety:** Fire behavior is forecasted today as being similar to yesterday. However, there is concern because of some subtle changes in the upper air weather. Therefore, stay alert for changes in the weather & fire behavior. Fire suppression response to new fire starts need to be quick & with timely effective use of aerial suppression support. Do not allow fires to build as they have enough energy to over ride existing environmental conditions.

Temperatures will be hotter again today along with lower humidity, so remain aware of what the fire is doing in your area especially, in the late afternoon. Plan and act accordingly. Maintain LCES at all times!

Accountability; it is very important to know and account for all personnel assigned to you. Accountability; it's a two way street. Accountability; personnel must receive a briefing prior to line assignments from your Division Supervisor. Accountability; know what to expect and you wont be surprised when it happens.

Be alert and pay attention to the details. There are logging operations in Sweat Farm Branch using the same narrow roads as you. Watch your speed especially as you travel by others.

Reburns are still a potential. Know where your escape routes and safety zones are located.

Snags are present, so be alert to any in your assignment area. Trees growing in peat soils can have weakened and burnt roots due to under ground burning that may allow them to fall without warning.

Hotter and drier means there will be a greater need for fluid intake. Start hydrating early in the day before the morning briefing and continue throughout the day. Don't wait until you're thirsty to drink because it will be more difficult to recover. Rehydration is enhanced when fluids contain sodium and potassium, or when foods with these electrolytes are consumed along with fluid.

When final approval and instructions are obtained the Demob U/L will:

### THE RELEASED CREW BOSS OR INDIVIDUAL OVERHEAD WILL:

- 1. Turn in all issued items, except communications gear, to the <u>Supply Unit</u> and obtain their release on the Demob Checkout ICS-221.
- 2. Obtain <u>Communication Unit</u> clearance on the Demob checkout showing all communication equipment has been returned.
- 3. Obtain <u>Facilities Unit</u> clearance on the Demob checkout showing that their area was left in good condition.
