

Weather Summary (See Today's Detailed Weather Forecast in the IAP):

Overnight RH recovery had no meaningful impact to fuel moistures. With today's forecasted weather, the windspeeds are favorable throughout the morning (CALM early AM & then E 5 -9 mph by 1000hrs). Windspeeds during the peak burning period are E 8 -12 mph w/ G to 17 mph. Cloud Cover will provide a positive impact to FB. It will tend to cap activity through decreased Air Temp, Fuel Temps, & higher RHs. Other factors working to cap FB are: lower Mixing Heights, Dispersion Index, & Haines Index as well as slower Transport Winds fire behavior may be at a higher level than expected.

<u>General Fire Behavior:</u> Yesterday, Bugaboo Scrub 2 fire perimeter was active along Division WG which experienced serious flare up and Division WI expanded with a breakover. These occurred late in the evening (~ 1700hrs). The winds did not come up to forecasted windspeeds until late in the day. The appearance of high veil cirrus clouds coupled with the smoke generated by the burnout operation on the Refuge, proved to be beneficial. These factors helped offset dangerously low RH range of 20%.

Today's probability of ignition is at 50%. New fire starts will ignite and spread best during the peak burning period, 1400 to 1900 hrs. Fire runs are approachable from the flanks, with prompt Initial Attack & aerial suppression support, fires can be contained quickly. Below is the expected fire behavior for respective fuel models. These can assist in time distance planning.

*note when the southern rough is > 4 ft tall these plantation are can easily support crown fire runs.

<u>All Fires:</u> Forest fuels are still dangerously dry. All containment lines on all fires need to be reviewed for threat of sleepers or reburn potential.

Air Operations: A moderate inversion & smoke presence limits aircraft visibility in the morning. Smoke production is expected & very poor visibility will be in the AM as winds will be CALM. If there is another burnout operation, this can again negatively impact air operations. All western fire perimeters remain impacted by smoke production.

Safety: There are still many sleepers over this vast fire area that have the potential to flare-up, spot, and grow to a significant size. Let's use the improving conditions and moderating weather to our advantage. Remember to keep in mind the seriousness of the dryness of larger sized fuels. They can still release a tremendous amount of heat that make control efforts difficult. Keep SAFETY fundamentals first, know your mission, and know your safety zones.

<u>EXTENDED: SATURDAY THROUGH TUESDAY:</u> Low pressure over the southeast Gulf of Mexico on Saturday is expected to move move across Florida over the weekend. A front will move into the Mississippi valley Sunday and to Georgia late Monday with increasing moisture in Southwest flow. Expect a chance of rain over the area during the

weekend with a lingering chance Monday and Tuesday during the approach of the front.

Saturday and Sunday: Partly cloudy. A 30 percent chance of showers or thunderstorms. Low in the Mid 60s highs in the Upper 80s. Min RH 34 to 38 percent. Afternoon winds East to Northeast 10 mph with gusts to 15 mph.

Monday and Tuesday: Mostly cloudy. A 20 percent chance of showers or thunderstorms. South to Southwest winds 5 to 10 mph with afternoon gusts to 15 mph. Min RH 37 to 43 percent.

Increasing clouds and relative humidity are expected. Temperatures will be warm again today. You need to remain aware of what the fire is doing in your area, especially in the late afternoon. Plan and act accordingly. Maintain LCES at all times!

Accountability; it is very important to know and account for all personnel assigned to you. Accountability; it's a two way street. Accountability; personnel must receive a briefing prior to line assignments from your Division Supervisor. Accountability; know what to expect and you wont be surprised when it happens.

Be alert and pay attention to the details. There are logging operations in Sweat Farm Branch using the same narrow roads as you. Watch your speed especially as you travel by others. Visibility can also be extremely poor over night and in the early morning time frame due to fog, smoke, and dust.

Reburns are still a potential. Know where your escape routes and safety zones are located.

Snags are present, so be alert to any in your assignment area. Trees growing in peat soils can have weakened and burnt roots due to under ground burning that may allow them to fall without warning.

As always, fluid intake is important. Start hydrating early in the day before the morning briefing and continue throughout the day. Don't wait until you're thirsty to drink because it will be more difficult to recover. Rehydration is enhanced when fluids contain sodium and potassium, or when foods with these electrolytes are consumed along with fluid.

When final approval and instructions are obtained the Demob U/L will:

THE RELEASED CREW BOSS OR INDIVIDUAL OVERHEAD WILL:

- 1. Turn in all issued items, except communications gear, to the <u>Supply Unit</u> and obtain their release on the Demob Checkout ICS-221.
- 2. Obtain <u>Communication Unit</u> clearance on the Demob checkout showing all communication equipment has been returned.
- 3. Obtain <u>Facilities Unit</u> clearance on the Demob checkout showing that their area was left in good condition.
- 4. Obtain <u>Ground Support Unit</u> or <u>Supply Unit</u> clearance on the Demob checkout indicating that all vehicles and keys were returned, and that contract equipment has been inspected.
