FUEL ASSUMPTIONS: Timber with shrub understory (pine plantation) will be the most active fuel type. Re-burn potential is very high. Current fuel conditions are favorable for very active to extreme fire behavior within all fuel types. Expect all fuels to burn readily, including those that appear green. Once fire becomes established, expect it to continue to run until it runs out of fuel.

General Fire Behavior Forecast: Extreme burning conditions! Expect rapid development and intense fire behavior in any areas of available fuel. Long range spotting and high rates of spread will occur once fire is established in areas of pine plantation with shrub understory. Control lines will be tested. Unburned or dirty burn pockets along bends in control lines are high potential for escape. This fire on multiple occasions has produced flame lengths in excess of 100 feet and spotting distances of 1 mile.

SPECIFICS: With westerly winds, re-burn will be pushed towards containment lines in Divisions M N O. Pay close attention to any portions of line where smoke may lay across your line.

Fire will remain very active in Divisions A Z, especially those areas that may be unlined.

Other divisions – smoldering, creeping, and re-burn. Reb-burn potential is very high.


Major Hazards & Risks: Extreme Fire Behavior, Aviation, Heavy Equipment, Driving

Fire Behavior: A fuels advisory (https://www.predictiveservices.nifc.gov/fuels_fire-danger/fuels_advisories.htm) was issued for this area in April and conditions have continued to get drier and hotter. Spotting distances of three quarters of a mile to one mile have been reported on the fire when it becomes very active and makes long runs. With predicted winds, temperatures and low humidity for today, take time to **identify lookouts**, **communications**, **escape routes and safety zones**.

Aviation: All aerial operations are based on strict protocols, mission evaluation and pilot acceptance. Everyone has a role to ensure safe flights and effective missions. **If you are unclear about something or see something that might be a hazard, speak up immediately.** In case of emergency, do not depend on aircraft for immediate assistance.

Heavy Equipment: Tractor plows are essential on this fire, **but tractors need good operators!** If you are an operator, take care of your health and don't injure yourself. Logging operations adjacent to the incident are on-going and will increase in the near future. Be aware of all logging operations and vehicles exiting and entering highways.

Driving: Driving continues to be the number one hazard for **ALL** resources on the incident. **ARE YOU RESTED**? Seven hours of rest are barely enough if you get it every day. **How many hours of sleep have you gotten in the past week?** If fatigue has become an issue for you, consider carpooling with others or allowing an alternate driver to fill in.

IWI IC Responsibilities:

- Take charge of the scene inform the Division Supervisor and Communications that you are the IWI IC and establish radio communications (frequencies, channels). Identify the emergency name Division A medical, Fish Meadows medical, Highway 21 accident.
- Assign or begin patient assessment (9 Line) and first aid. Request additional medical resources on division/branch or across incident. Transmit 9 Line patient information to Communications.
- Determine patient transportation through consultation with line medical personnel and Medical Unit Leader. Consider transportation time, risk to personnel, destination facility and available operational resources. If air transport is chosen, implement the plan for alternative transportation in the event aircraft cannot complete the mission. Order transportation resources through Communications as early as possible.
- Notify Communications as resources arrive and any patient status changes. Names of injured or deceased individuals will not be transmitted on the radio
- Initiate documentation for future investigation; if a line safety officer is available, assign them to lead documentation. Do not move deceased individuals, gear or personal effects except to accomplish rescue work or protect the safety of others. Obtain written documentation of witnesses. The Unit Log, ICS 214, may be used for the initial documentation, but a subsequent narrative will be required.
- As appropriate, conduct an After Action Review to determine successes, areas to improve and lessons learned.


