**DISCUSSION:** High pressure will shift southeast of the region as a frontal system approaches the Mississippi River Valley Friday. Clouds will increase over the area with a continuation of warm temperatures near 90 degrees. Minimum humidity will range in the mid to upper 20% range. Breezy west to southwest winds will increase to near 10-15 mph with gusts up to 25 mph through the day.

**FUEL ASSUMPTIONS:** Timber with shrub understory (pine plantation) will be the most active fuel type. Re-burn potential is very high. Current fuel conditions are favorable for very active to extreme fire behavior within all fuel types. Expect all fuels to burn readily, including those that appear green. Once fire becomes established, expect it to continue to run until it runs out of fuel.

#### The fuel moisture for today is:

Calculated 1 hr fuel 3%, 10 hr fuel 6%, 100 hr fuel 14%

ERC levels have been trending at or above 97 Percentile KBDI – 729

Critical fire behavior thresholds: 1 HR Fuel Moisture <6%, RHs below 40% and a Dispersion Index greater than 60.

WEATHER: Partly cloudy, warm and dry. West winds at 10-15 by late morning, with gusts to 20-25 by midday. Winds will become more WSW in the afternoon.

Max temp: 88-93 Min RH 25-30% LAL 1 Chance Rain 0%

Dispersion 80 Mixing Height: 5900 Transport Winds: West-Southwest 20-25 mph

General Fire Behavior Forecast: Extreme burning conditions! Winds are forecast to increase today, which will add to an already volatile fuel situation. Expect rapid development and intense fire behavior in any areas of available fuel. Long range spotting and high rates of spread will occur once fire is established in areas of pine plantation with shrub understory. Control lines will be tested. This fire on multiple occasions has produced flame lengths in excess of 100 feet and spotting distances of 1 mile.

SPECIFICS: With southwesterly winds, re-burn will be pushed towards containment lines in Divisions M N O. Pay close attention to any portions of line where smoke may lay across your line.

Fire will remain very active in Divisions A Z, especially those areas that may be unlined.

The swamp itself may begin to see activity with the return of SW winds.

Other divisions – smoldering, creeping, and re-burn. Reb-burn potential is very high.

Initial Attack – Expect rapid development and high intensity on any new starts.

**INCIDENT:** West Mims Fire DATE: Friday, May 12, 2017

Major Hazards & Risks: Extreme Fire Behavior, Aviation, Heavy Equipment, Driving

**Fire Behavior:** Today, spotting will continue to be a major concern. Winds will increase and make control of spots very difficult. Look out, Communicate and identify **E**scape routes to **S**afety Zones. Know the location of all personnel throughout the shift. Be clear on communication before engaging on spots or escapes. Read the fuels advisory at <a href="https://www.predictiveservices.nifc.gov/fuels">https://www.predictiveservices.nifc.gov/fuels</a> fire-danger/fuels advisories.htm.

**Aviation:** There are many aircraft operating on this incident. A helicopter made an unplanned landing at a dip site recently. You can help by keeping an eye open for aviation hazards and for unplanned landings. **Aviation protocols are critical, especially with so many missions. Make the time to do it right.** 

**Heavy Equipment:** *Identify and clarify the travel route for equipment, especially for resources arriving after briefing.* Be sure there is sufficient road clearance and capacity, especially over bridges. Use V-blades, watch for stumps and work in tandem. Allow enough space between fire's edge and tractor work to react to wind shift.

**Driving:** Everyone drives or rides to reach their assignment. Be alert for new hazards along your road. **Yesterday there were three close calls between our drivers and pedestrians or bicyclists in Lake City.** Low light, dark clothing and distracted citizens were factors, so consider them when driving in towns.



If a train blocks your egress at a railroad crossing and an emergency develops, locate the blue sign, find the crossing number, call the railroad police and explain the situation. They can begin moving the train in 4 minutes. Remember...only Superman is faster than a speeding train...or Chuck Yeager.

- Take charge of the scene inform the Division Supervisor and Communications that you are the IWI IC and establish radio communications (frequencies, channels). Identify the emergency name Division A medical, Fish Meadows medical, Highway 21 accident.
- Assign or begin patient assessment (9 Line) and first aid. Request additional medical resources on division/branch or across incident. Transmit 9 Line patient information to Communications.
- Determine patient transportation through consultation with line medical personnel and Medical Unit Leader. Consider transportation time, risk to personnel, destination facility and available operational resources. If air transport is chosen, implement the plan for alternative transportation in the event aircraft cannot complete the mission. Order transportation resources through Communications as early as possible.
- Notify Communications as resources arrive and any patient status changes. Names of injured or deceased individuals will not be transmitted on the radio.
- Initiate documentation for future investigation; if a line safety officer is available, assign them to lead documentation. Do not move deceased individuals, gear or personal effects except to accomplish rescue work or protect the safety of others. Obtain written documentation of witnesses. The Unit Log, ICS 214, may be used for the initial documentation, but a subsequent narrative will be required.
- As appropriate, conduct an After Action Review to determine successes, areas to improve and lessons learned.




