DISCUSSION: Much drier conditions are expected today trailing this morning's cold front passage as high pressure builds across the area from the Gulf Coast region. Above normal daytime high temperatures will continue. Light north winds will prevail and become near calm by evening. Smoke mixed with patchy fog is expected tonight and could cause localized significant visibility restrictions, especially in low lying drainages.

FIRE BEHAVIOR

GENERAL:

Winds from the Northwest will cause containment issues on the south and southeast portions of the fire today. Spotting distances will be up to 2/10ths of a mile and probability of ignition (PIG) tops out around 75%.

Re-burns have already been an issue and will likely be more so today. Yesterday's winds blowing through previously burned stands will have produced a large amount of needle cast on the ground. High temperatures today, with the extremely low RH, will make them highly available for consumption. This will be an issue anywhere the fire has previously burned through Pine stands with enough intensity to scorch the crown without consuming the needles.

Fuel moistures and ERC's continue to be at record levels. Fire has burned much of what is available for consumption at this time within the planned containment area. Nevertheless, as the weather continues to be hot and dry, those areas that haven't carried fire previously will, at some point, become prone to fire spread.

SPECIFIC:

DIV A/O: Residual heat will remain along the Six Rd. where burnout operations took place previously, especially on the northeast portion of Soldier Island. Northwest winds will push that portion of the fire burning uncontained between Soldier Island and the swamp edge break to the southeast until it burns into fuels too wet to carry fire. On the west portion of DIV A, watch for re-burn along the perimeter.

DIV B/C: Re-burn will likely be an issue in these divisions today. With northwest winds, flare-ups along the south perimeter could cause containment issues.

DIV D/E: Fire that has been backing south on Billy's Island will have more wind behind it and push to the south faster than we've seen in previous days. If it burns far enough south there are fuels available for it to carry to the east towards the canal. If planned burnout operations along Hwy 177 take place today expect moderate fire spread through the Pine/Palmetto/Gallberry understory, but little to no fire spread interior when it reaches the Cyprus/brush fuel type with very wet grounds beneath it at this time.

DIV M/N: Northwest winds will continue to threatened containment lines along the eastern side of the fire. Short runs toward the perimeter are possible and could create spotting issues, particularly on the south end of DIV N.

AIR OPERATIONS:

Fire behavior and weather are unlikely to impact air operations today.

SAFETY

Hearing "**Cold Front Passage**" in a weather briefing should always trigger the hairs on the back of your neck to stand up. Many of our tragic wildfire events have been associated with winds before and following a cold front. Be alert and make sound, risk based decisions with worst case fire behavior scenarios in mind.

Training Specialist Message

The following contains information for both trainee and trainer/evaluators regarding the incident training program. The information is to assist you in planning your activities.

- 1) Trainee and Mentor/Evaluator register with Training Specialist (TNSP)
- 2) It is not necessary to be assigned to the incident as a trainee to receive credit for your assignment. If you have an open task book initiated by your home unit take the opportunity to accomplish tasks and receive credit.
- 3) It is only necessary to follow up with the TNSP during your assignment if you have any significant issues i.e. Changes in assignment/trainer problem with assignments etc.
- 4) Trainer and evaluator **MUST** “close out” with TNSP prior to Demob. The closeout process involves:
 - ✓ The trainer completing an individual performance evaluation (ICS 225/226)
 - ✓ The trainee will complete an exit interview form. Forms are available at the TNSP desk
 - ✓ The evaluator should have all work completed in the position taskbook at the time training assignment closeout. Including a recommendation as to the recommendation of the assignment i.e. recommend certification, needs more assignments, etc.
- 5) If you have reached a point where as much work can be done in the book as possible on this incident, you may perform the close out process with the TNSP prior to Demob which could save you time and a potential wait in line.

Collector for ArcGIS- Mobile Mapping App

Instructions



Situation Unit and GISS have implemented use of the Collector app for mobile mapping on the West Mims Fire. There are two types of users: Collector and Viewer. Anyone assigned to the incident can view mobile maps, and some will be designated to collect new data using the mobile maps. The data collected using Collector can be served directly to the Situation Unit as proposed. All new data must then be reviewed and approved by the Situation Unit Leader before it will show up on printed map products.

You must have an ArcGIS Online (AGOL) account to login to the Collector app for viewing or collecting. Many agencies have their own accounts. If you have an agency account, you can provide your account username to your DIVS. They will then provide that information to SIT.

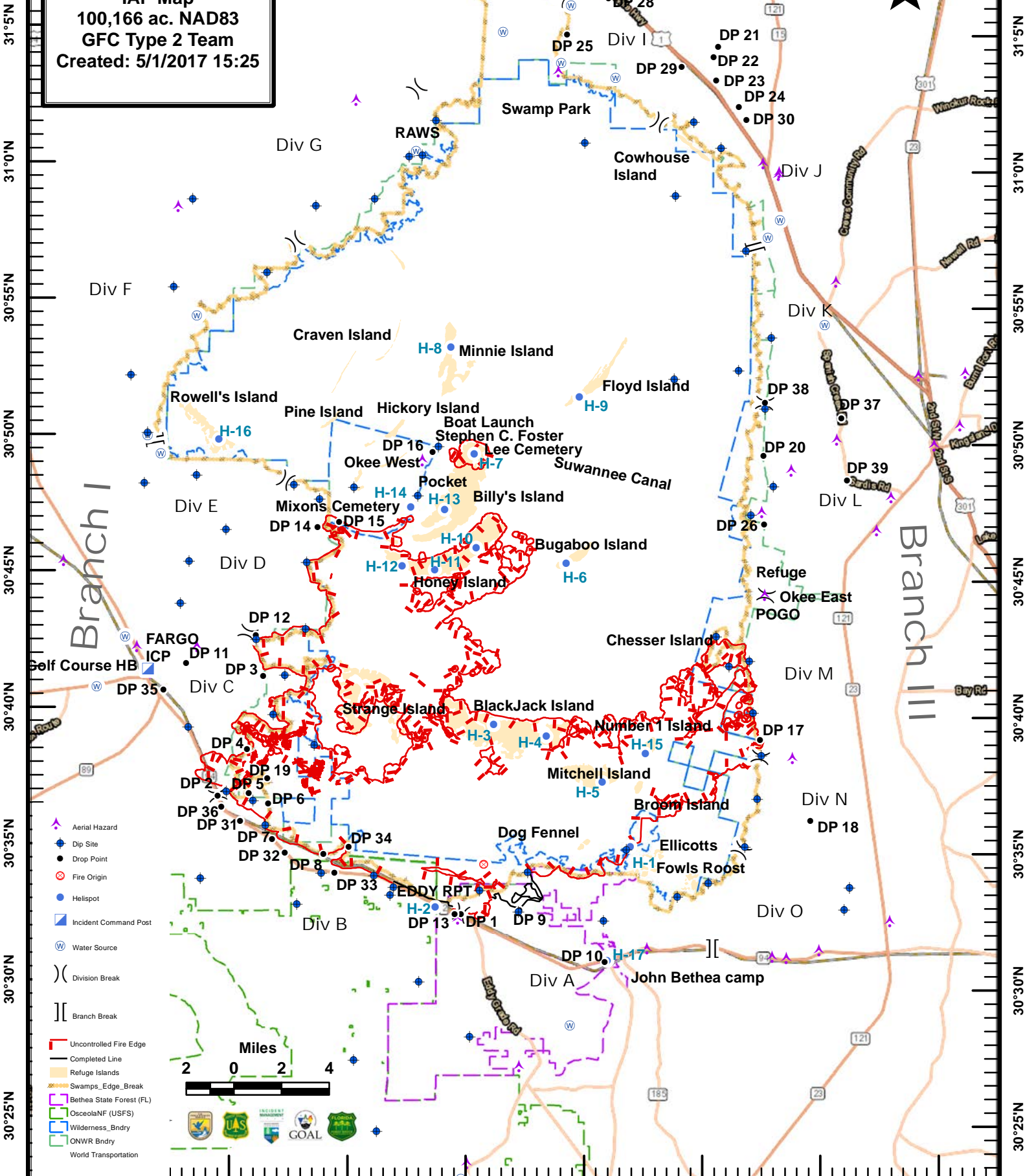
If you don't have an AGOL account, you can request an account through the NIFC organization for AGOL using the following web link: <http://nifc.maps.arcgis.com/home/index.html>

You will receive an email to activate your account. After you receive your user name and set up your password, you can then provide your user name to your DIVS, and they will submit it to SIT.

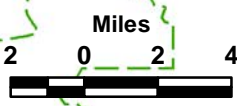
If you need training on how to download maps for offline use in the field, let your DIVS know. **TIP:** When using Collector in the field turn your mobile device on airplane mode to save battery life.
