FIRE BEHAVIOR

GENERAL:

Today's temperatures, relative humidity, and dispersion will be similar to yesterday. Winds will nearly reverse themselves today and fire behavior will follow suit. East winds in the morning will push fire against the west swamp edge break. Later, winds rotate to a southeast direction. Areas of most concern today are the entire west swamp edge break, the north end of Billy's island, and northwest corner of Chesser Island.

Fuel moistures and ERC's continue to be at record levels. Fire has burned much of what is available for consumption at this time within the planned containment area. Nevertheless, as the weather continues to be hot and dry, those areas that haven't carried fire previously will, at some point, become prone to fire spread.

For today expect maximum rates of spread to be 30-40 chains/hour and maximum flame lengths to be 8-10 feet. Good ventilation will allow for increased fireline intensity, similar to yesterday.

SPECIFIC:

DIV A/O: Backing fire will continue to burn between Soldier Island and the swamp edge break to the southeast where fuels will allow. On the west portion of DIV A, watch for re-burn along the perimeter.

DIV B/C: Re-burn will likely be an issue in these divisions today. With east winds, flare-ups along the west perimeter in DIV C may cause containment issues.

DIV D/E: Residual heat along Hwy 177 from yesterday's burnout operation will cause flare ups near the containment lines. In the interior, Billy's Island will continue backing south. ESE winds may cause flare up on north end that could threaten containment along the canal.

DIV M/N: ESE winds today will push heat away from containment lines today. Residual heat along containment lines is likely, especially on the southern portion where intense fire behavior was exhibited yesterday.

AIR OPERATIONS:

Fire behavior and weather are unlikely to impact air operations today.

SAFETY

Wind increased or changes directions. The winds of this fire have changed almost daily and today is no exception. Winds will nearly reverse themselves and come out of the east southeast. What does that mean to you? Your division? Your tactics?

Wisdom is not a belief, a value, or a set of facts. Wisdom is an attitude taken towards knowledge, belief, information, abilities and skill. "Wisdom" is the quality of having expert knowledge accompanied by an understanding that what one knows is usually incomplete and fallible, and that acting on that fallible knowledge involves a tricky balance between knowing and doubting. This is risk management.

On this incident, the accident with the greatest probability of occurring is unsure footing i.e. slips and falls. The greatest potential of loss is an incident involving a vehicle accident.

Sure footing is accomplished when you have appropriate balance, 1) as you walk and/or step onto or over obstacles and 2) when using fire tools and equipment. Being in good physical condition is critical when working and walking in the incident fire zones.

To reduce the risk injury/accident from a driving mishap drive defensively and with seat belts fastened. Do a walk around before moving vehicle. On long trips take periodic breaks.

Logging Activity: Division Charlie will have multiple logging contractors on Council road. Stay away from their cutting site. Watch for reburn potential in area. Watch for trucks and equipment on roads. Watch for trucks enter and exiting off HWY 94. Use L.E. if needed.

Standard Firefighting Order #10—Fight fire aggressively, having provided for safety first.

Watch Out Situation #5—Uninformed on strategy, tactics, and hazards.

If you don't have an education, you have to use your brain.

Training Specialist Message


The following contains information for both trainee and trainer/evaluators regarding the incident training program. The information is to assist you in planning your activities.

- 1) Trainee and Mentor/Evaluator register with Training Specialist (TNSP)
- 2) It is not necessary to be assigned to the incident as a trainee to receive credit for your assignment. If you have an open task book initiated by your home unit take the opportunity to accomplish tasks and receive credit.
- 3) It is only necessary to follow up with the TNSP during your assignment if you have any significant issues i.e. Changes in assignment/trainer problem with assignments etc.
- 4) Trainer and evaluator MUST "close out" with TNSP prior to Demob. The closeout process involves:
 - ✓ The trainer completing an individual performance evaluation (ICS 225/226)
 - ✓ The trainee will complete an exit interview form. Forms are available at the TNSP desk
 - ✓ The evaluator should have all work completed in the position taskbook at the time training assignment closeout. Including a recommendation as to the recommendation of the assignment i.e. recommend certification, needs more assignments, etc.
- 5) If you have reached a point where as much work can be done in the book as possible on this incident, you may perform the close out process with the TNSP prior to Demob which could save you time and a potential wait in line.

Collector for ArcGIS- Mobile Mapping App Instructions



You must have an ArcGIS Online (AGOL) account to login to the Collector app for viewing or collecting. Many agencies have their own accounts. If you have an agency account, you can provide your account username to your DIVS. They will then provide that information to SIT.

If you don't have an AGOL account, you can request an account through the NIFC organization for AGOL using the following web link: http://nifc.maps.arcgis.com/home/index.html

You will receive an email to activate your account. After you receive your user name and set up your password, you can then provide your user name to your DIVS, and they will submit it to SIT.

If you need training on how to download maps for offline use in the field, let your DIVS know. **TIP:** When using Collector in the field turn your mobile device on airplane mode to save battery life.
