FUEL ASSUMPTIONS: Timber with shrub understory (pine plantation) will be the most active fuel type. Re-burn potential is very high. Current fuel conditions are favorable for very active fire behavior within all fuel types. Expect all fuels to burn readily, including those that appear green. Once fire becomes established, expect it to continue to run until it runs out of fuel.

The fuel moisture for today is:

Calculated 1 hr fuel 2%, 10 hr fuel 6%, 100 hr fuel 14%

ERC levels have been above 97 Percentile KBDI – 718

Critical fire behavior thresholds: 1 HR Fuel Moisture <6%, RHs below 40% and a Dispersion Index greater than 60.

WEATHER: Mostly sunny and hot. Continued very dry.

Wind: (20ft) Light and Variable less than 5 mph in the am. Variable directions in the pm hours at 5 to 10 mph

General Fire Behavior Forecast: Extreme burning conditions! Expect rapid development and intense fire behavior in any areas of available fuel. Long range spotting and high rates of spread will occur once fire is established in areas of pine plantation with shrub understory. Control lines will be tested. Unburned or dirty burn pockets along bends in control lines are high potential for escape. Potential exists for plume dominated fire and associated column collapse.

SPECIFICS: Divisions Oscar/Zulu/Alpha will be active very early in the burn period. Any unlined portions of fire will likely be active and moving at the onset of the shift.

Other divisions – smoldering and creeping. Reb-burn potential is very high.

INCIDENT: West Mims Fire DATE: Tuesday, May 9, 2017

Major Hazards & Risks: Extreme Fire Behavior, Hydration, Driving, Aviation

Fire Behavior: Fuels continue to dry out more each day. Fuel moisture levels and KBDI are at extreme levels, which influence fuels in many ways. Don't be fooled by the lush green appearance of local vegetation. **LCES must be established before engagement**. Set Management Action Points and be prepared to disengage and reassess early if necessary. Know the location of your escape route and safety zone before they are needed.

Hydration: With warm and dry conditions predicted for the next several days, **hydration** will be extremely important to prevent dehydration and more serious health issues. While performing strenuous work, drink at least 1 quart of liquid per hour, making sure that your urine is clear. **Avoid drinking only sport and energy drinks** that are concentrated and high in sodium and sugars.

Aviation: Aviation resources continue to be a very important source in fire suppression activities on the incident. Understand the correct protocol when utilizing them. Review the first **Aviation Watch Out Situation, IRPG p. 44**. when contemplating aviation resource needs.

Driving: Driver fatigue/asleep is the number one cause of distracted driving. Continue to be diligent when driving long distances and working long hours. **Maintain the 2:1 work rest guidelines.**

IWI IC Responsibilities:

- Take charge of the scene inform the Division Supervisor and Communications that you are the IWI IC and establish radio communications (frequencies, channels). Identify the emergency name – Division A medical, Fish Meadows medical, Highway 21 accident.
- Assign or begin patient assessment (9 Line) and first aid. Request additional medical resources on division/branch or across incident. Transmit 9 Line patient information to Communications.
- Determine patient transportation through consultation with line medical personnel and Medical Unit Leader. Consider transportation time, risk to personnel, destination facility and available operational resources. If air transport is chosen, implement the plan for alternative transportation in the event aircraft cannot complete the mission. Order transportation resources through Communications as early as possible.
- Notify Communications as resources arrive and any patient status changes. Names of injured or deceased individuals will not be transmitted on the radio.
- Initiate documentation for future investigation; if a line safety officer is available, assign them to lead documentation. Do not move
 deceased individuals, gear or personal effects except to accomplish rescue work or protect the safety of others. Obtain written
 documentation of witnesses. The Unit Log, ICS 214, may be used for the initial documentation, but a subsequent narrative will be required.
- As appropriate, conduct an After Action Review to determine successes, areas to improve and lessons learned.

SITUATION UNIT MESSAGE: Collector for ArcGIS-Mobile Mapping App Instructions



Situation Unit and GISS have implemented use of the Collector app for mobile mapping on the West Mims Fire. There are two types of users: Collector and Viewer. Anyone assigned to the incident can view mobile maps, and some will be designated to collect new data using the mobile maps. The data collected using Collector can be served direct.

new data using the mobile maps. The data collected using Collector can be served directly to the Situation Unit as proposed. All new data must then be reviewed and approved by the Situation Unit Leader before it will show up on printed map products.

You must have an ArcGIS Online (AGOL) account to login to the Collector app for viewing or collecting. Many agencies have their own accounts. If you have an agency account, you can provide your account username to your DIVS. They will then provide that information to SIT. If you don't have an AGOL account, you can request an account through the NIFC organization for AGOL using the following web link: http://nifc.maps.arcgis.com/home/index.html

You will receive an email to activate your account. After you receive your user name, set up your password and recovery security question. You can then provide your user name to your DIVS, and they will submit it to SIT.

If you need training on how to download maps for offline use in the field, let your DIVS know. **TIP:** When using Collector in the field turn your mobile device on airplane mode to save battery life.

REMINDER: To update map perimeters, please download maps each morning after 0800.


