<u>DISCUSSION:</u> An upper level disturbance is expected to more over the region today with somewhat unstable conditions for the fire. Areas of morning fog and smoke will mix out by mid-morning with moderate easterly winds increasing and become gusty in the afternoon as the Atlantic sea breeze moves over the fire area.


Major Hazards and Risks: Urban Wildland Interface, Extreme Fire Behavior Some thoughts from Paul Gleason, the creator of the LCES concept.

Wildland/Urban Interface - Suppression in the Urban Wildland Interface presents its own unique set of problems. The choice of fire line location is often influenced by the homes which stand between the fire front and a "better" option. Often the standard tactics of anchoring at the rear (or heel) and flanking, will leave improvements in the path of the wind driven fire.

The lack of an ideal fire line location does not in itself constitute unsafe indirect strategy. The "urgency" of the operation causes a breakdown in solid tactics. During interface suppression operations, maybe more than any other operation, the LCES System <u>must</u> be in place.

With the rapid spread rates reached by wind driven fires only two options are available. The traditional "anchor and flank strategy or the unorthodox protection of improvements and resources as the wildfire spreads past. The last dictates the necessity for a "defensible space" around each improvement sufficient to serve also as a safety zone, a true safety zone. Unless this precaution has been made, the risk of defending the improvement may not be worth the operation.

Escape Route/Safety Zone Checklist

Escape Routes:

- *More than one escape route
- *Scouted soils, vegetation, slope
- *Timed slowest person, fatigue, dozer speed
- *Marked flagged for day and night use

Safety Zones:

- *Survivable without a shelter
- *Natural clean burn, water, bare soil/rock
- *Manmade constructed sites, roads
- *Scouted for size and hazards
- *Close enough considering escape time needed

Remember and Follow:

- *The 10 Standard Fire Orders
- *The 18 Situations That Shout Watch Out
- *The Common Denominators of Fire Behavior on **Tragedy Fires**
- *The Downhill Line Construction Guidelines



- Proper Authorization (Legible name and O#)

- All accountable property (anything with a serial number such as chainsaws, pump kits, etc...) must have a DIVS (or above) signature and O# on the 213
- ➤ Anything below accountable property must have single resource boss (or above) signature and O# on the 213

✓ Go to Medical Unit for:

- Basic Over-the-Counter Medicines
- Any medical welfare related needs

✓ Go to Communications Unit for:


