3. Objective(s):

• Provide for the safety and security of incident personnel and public in all incident operations through sound risk assessment and hazard mitigations.

• Maintain a positive working relationship with all adjacent landowners, cooperators State and Federal partners. Inform, involve and communicate incident planning and operations with all partners.

• Confine all fires that are within the Okefenokee National Wildlife Refuge, inside the Refuge and/or inside the swamp edge break if possible.

 In cooperation with local timberland owners, use full suppression strategies and tactics to minimize damage to private timberlands and improvements and to prevent fires outside the Refuge from entering the Refuge.

• Assist in management and suppression of additional fires (new starts or breakouts) in the vicinity as approved by Agency Administrators and Unified Incident Commanders.

• Protect all cultural and archeological sites and structures within the refuge.

• Manage the fires cost-effectively consistent with the values at risk.

• Implement structure protection as necessary for at-risk facilities and communities.

Coordinate suppression actions with assigned Refuge Resource Advisors to protect endangered species.
Conduct all operations in a harassment-free environment. There will be a no tolerance atmosphere for

harassment, alcohol, or illegal drug use. Everyone will be treated with dignity and respect.

Keep fire within the Okefenokee Refuge Swamp Edge Break Boundary. Respond to initial attack fires on new starts within: \*South of Suwannee Canal

LAL: 1, CWR: 0%, DISPERSION: 75-80 MAX OUTPUTS FIRE BEHAVIOR **GENERAL:** Increased temperatures and dispersion will lead to amplified fire behavior today compared to vesterday. Winds out of the west northwest will continue to push the fire east and flank to the south. Active heads are expected to burn 1-2 miles in a southeast directions. These will be in the Honey Island and Mitchell Island areas. These island burned previously in the 2011 Honey Prairie Fire and now consist of Slash Pine overstory with a heavy Palmetto understory. Even with near 100% recovery these islands are able to continue burning through the night hours. Rates of spread will be slow but fire will progress across the islands to the east. The fire front that burned actively to and through Blackjack island has reached some wetter, patchy fuels and will have to weave its way through to more available fuels to the north. Rates of spread tomorrow are predicted to be around 3-6 ch/hr, but with direct wind short runs of 30-40 ch/hr are likely. Flame lengths will be 2-4 ft in most areas, but 6-10 ft in taller fuel types. SPECIFIC: **DIV A:** As fire continues to burn south and east it will it will work its way towards the southern swamp edge east of the fire origin, near Moonshine Ridge. **DIV B:** Little to no fire activity along the perimeter. Some internal pockets of unburned fuel continue to consume. **DIV C:** Most of the active fire behavior is well interior and burning away from containment lines. Some pockets of heat remain near the lines and some fire activity may be observed in these areas. **DIV D:** Winds will push the fire to the east, but available fuels on Billy's Island will propel fire northward towards the State Park. If a burnout is conducted along Hwy177 winds will carry fire away or parallel to the containment lines. **DIV M/N/O:** Fire will again push towards these divisions today. Expect fire to move approximately 1 mile to the east during today's burn period. AIR OPERATIONS:

Air operations should not be affected by fire behavior or weather today.

**Base all actions on current and expected behavior of the fire**. We know roughly what the fire behavior should be today and where it is headed. Base your actions on that, but always be ready for the unexpected.

Wisdom is not a belief, a value, or a set of facts. Wisdom is an **attitude** taken towards knowledge, belief, information, abilities and skill. "Wisdom" is the quality of having expert knowledge accompanied by an understanding that what one knows is usually incomplete and fallible, and that acting on that fallible knowledge involves a tricky balance between knowing and doubting. This is risk management.

On this incident, the accident with the greatest probability of occurring is unsure footing i.e. slips and falls. The greatest potential of loss is an incident involving a vehicle accident.

Sure footing is accomplished when you have appropriate balance 1) as you walk and/or step onto or over obstacles and 2) when using fire tools and equipment. Being in good physical condition is critical when working and walking in the incident fire zones.

To reduce the risk injury/accident from a driving mishap drive defensively and with seat belts fastened. Do a walk around before moving vehicle. On long trips take periodic breaks.

Standard Firefighting Order #9—Maintain control of your forces at all times.

Watch Out Situation #4—Unfamiliar with weather and local factors influencing fire behavior.

#### If you don't have an education, you have to use your brain.


