<u>DISCUSSION:</u> Weak high pressure over the Florida Peninsula is expected to produce hot temperatures around 90 degrees with very dry RHs in the lower 30 percent range for the fire area. Moderate winds are expected to continue to back southwest to southerly through the day.

OUTPUTS

FIRE BEHAVIOR

GENERAL:

Fuels continue to be extremely dry. Winds coming out of the south today will again rotate the forward progression the fire to the north. Expect head fires to move in a north direction with the east flank being the aggressively burning side. Fire growth 1-2 miles to the northeast is predicted today and 2-3 more miles tomorrow.

When the fire gets the opportunity to move across the swamp through the lighter flashy fuels it can do so very quickly with a wind behind it. Rates of spread up to 50 chains/hr may occur for short duration with steadier ROS of 20-30 ch/hr. Flame lengths are around 2-4 ft. As the fire works through timbered understory rates of spread are reduced but fire intensity increases. Expect rates of spread to be 5-10 ch/hr with flame heights of 10-14 ft.

SPECIFIC:

DIV A/O: Fire will continue to back to the south to the swamp edge and across Soldier Camp Island.

DIV B: Internal pockets of fuel continue to burn out.

DIV C: Most of the active fire behavior is well interior and will be burning parallel to containment lines. Watch for these to start burning onto Strange Island.

DIV D: Expect a lot of heat to remain, especially where ignitions took place yesterday. Spotting across the swamp edge break is possible, especially along the Jack Sikes Rd. and north of DP15.

DIV M/N: Fire will continue flanking to the east off of Mitchell Island. Moderate growth is expected today and as early as the following day fire could push to the swamp edge in these divisions.

AIR OPERATIONS:

No impact from weather or fire behavior.

SAFETY

As resources begin to shift to keep up with fire progression many will find themselves in unfamiliar areas. Make sure you know the fuel types and burning conditions in those areas and more importantly know your ingress/egress routes before fire behavior forces you to use them.

Driving:

Driving to and from motel and work assignments continues to be the riskiest activity we do. Statistically, it is the cause of most firefighter fatalities and severe injuries. Maintain your situational awareness when driving and keep a good attitude, be attentive, and be sure the vehicle has been maintained appropriately. Wear your seat belt, lights on, obey speed limits, do not use cell phones while driving and be careful backing.

Situational Awareness:

Remember, 60% of your situational awareness comes from hearing. So, if you are around heavy equipment, chain saws, trains, car/truck traffic, helicopters, pumps, etc. your S.A. is affected by more than half. Learn how to mitigate the hazards (ear plugs, heightened LCES, change location, etc.) and keep an eye on your crewmates and others.

Accident/Injury Procedures:

In your daily safety sessions, practice "What if ..." scenarios about how you would medivac a serious injury from your location. Review the Medical Plan and pages 108 & 109 in your IRPG. Do you know what color the Medical Section is???

LEADER'S INTENT

All leaders of firefighters have the responsibility to provide complete briefings and ensure that their subordinates have a clear understanding of their **intent** for the assignment:

TASK--What is to be done? PURPOSE--Why it is to be done. END STATE--How it should look when done.


