**DISCUSSION:** High pressure will hold over the region with record hot temperatures around 95 degrees with dry RHs in the mid 30 percent range for the fire area. Southerly winds with competing and colliding Atlantic and Gulf sea breezes may produce isolated late afternoon thunderstorms today.

## INPUTS

**WEATHER:** Areas of smoke and fog in the morning, then becoming partly sunny and hot in the afternoon.

**WIND (20 FT):** South 4-6 mph in the morning, increasing to 8 to 10 mph gusts to around 15 mph in the afternoon.

**MAX TEMPERATURES:** 91 to 95.

**MIN RH:** 34-39%.

## OUTPUTS

### FIRE BEHAVIOR

#### GENERAL:

Extremely hot weather combined with low RH, gusty winds and a high dispersion level will allow significant fire growth where continuous dry fuels are available. The fire continues to burn into wetter, less available fuels, tempering large fire growth. The parameters are still in place for the fire to make strong pulses to the north in locations where fuels are available.

Watch for a continued pattern of low to moderate fire behavior until 1600 when RH bottoms out and temperatures peak. The fires main growth period has consistently been from 1600 to 1900. After 1900 RH's begin to increase quickly and reduce the activity considerably.

Head fire (short durations): ROS- 50-75 ch/hr, FL4-6 ft.

Flanking/Backing fire: ROS 5-10 ch/hr, FL 10-14 ft.

#### SPECIFIC:

**DIV A:** Fire has backed or been brought to the containment lines and swamp edge break. Expect residual pockets of heat and interior unburned fuels to be active today.

**DIV B/C:** Little fire behavior is expected near containment lines. Interior continues to burn to the south backing into the wind in the Strange Island area. With southeast winds in the afternoon there is a slight possibility that fire could make a push at the Bugneck Rd. which is one of the few areas that fire could push through to the west.

**DIV D/E:** Limited heat remains along the containment lines. Most fire activity is well interior. Southeast winds in the afternoon may push fire across Billy's Island towards the State Park. Strategic firing from yesterday on the north end of Billy's island will continue to flank south and west.

**DIV M:** If not kept it check by aerial resources, the east flank still has the ability to progress to the north towards Chesser Island and flank east towards the swamp edge break.

**DIV N/O:** Fire north of Soldier Camp Island will continue backing to the southeast towards the swamp edge break into wet areas that are not prone to burning.

#### AIR OPERATIONS:

Fire behavior is unlikely to affect air operations today. Heavy smoke will push west of POGO in the afternoon.

## SAFETY

**Cannot see main fire, not in contact with anyone who can.** In this "flat" terrain it can be very difficult to find lookout locations that can see the fire's location and behavior. Mitigate this by staying in close communication with air attack and recon flights. It is not acceptable to assume you know where the fire is and what it's doing.

- Continue to be safe while driving; look out for smoke/fog on road ways. Increase following distance with low visibility. Watch all RR crossing, and while working around RR.
- Have flashlight, batteries, wear safety light, watch footing & stay awake.
- Extreme Fire Behavior can be expected over most of our response area. Use all available resources to keep everyone safe.
- Keep clean, wash your hands, don't spread your germs
- Assure Communications are clear and understood
- As we have all seen lately...UWI can become part of every fire we go on. Remember priorities.
- Make sure the operator see's you before approaching.
- Only use air resources when absolutely necessary. This is a very good resource to utilize but remember there is an added risk also.
- Drink plenty of fluids. Strive to drink enough to P-N-3 (enough fluids flushing your system so as to urinate every 3 hours.

There are many things we can do to keep all firefighters as safe as possible. Just by covering LCES on EVERY fire will help. Be sure that fresh batteries are in hand held radios, flashlights, etc. Check PPE...fire shelters...NOMEX...drinking water. Also, keep warm clothing in case of late night fires.

This is a very serious situation but if we all use our experience and training, we should be able to keep accidents and injuries to a minimum. Follow up with an AAR after shift.

# Collector for ArcGIS- Mobile Mapping App

## Instructions



Situation Unit and GISS have implemented use of the Collector app for mobile mapping on the West Mims Fire. There are two types of users: Collector and Viewer. Anyone assigned to the incident can view mobile maps, and some will be designated to collect new data using the mobile maps. The data collected using Collector can be served directly to the Situation Unit as proposed. All new data must then be reviewed and approved by the Situation Unit Leader before it will show up on printed map products.

You must have an ArcGIS Online (AGOL) account to login to the Collector app for viewing or collecting. Many agencies have their own accounts. If you have an agency account, you can provide your account username to your DIVS. They will then provide that information to SIT.

If you don't have an AGOL account, you can request an account through the NIFC organization for AGOL using the following web link: <http://nifc.maps.arcgis.com/home/index.html>

You will receive an email to activate your account. After you receive your user name and set up your password, you can then provide your user name to your DIVS, and they will submit it to SIT.

If you need training on how to download maps for offline use in the field, let your DIVS know. **TIP:** When using Collector in the field turn your mobile device on airplane mode to save battery life.
