DISCUSSION: A dry cold front will push south of the fire site today with WNW winds becoming more NW into the afternoon. Wind gusts will not be as high today as previous days, but will still gust up to 20-25 mph by midday. Very dry conditions will continue across the area with slightly warmer temperatures. #### **FUEL ASSUMPTIONS:**

#### General Fire Behavior Forecast: ... High Potential for large fire growth... EXTREME CONDITIONS

Active burning should be expected in all areas of the fire that have available fuel. If the fire gets established in pine plantations very high rates of spread should be expected. Short and long range spotting should be expected ahead of the fire.

#### SPECIFIC:

**DIV** A/O: Fire will continue to burn between Soldier Island Camp RD and the swamp edge break to the southeast where fuels will allow. The Fowls Roost area will continue to burn and create potential for spotting across the control lines. On the west portion of DIV A, watch for re-burn along the perimeter. Be on the lookout for long range spotting from interior burning.

**DIV B/C:** Re-burn potential is very high today.

**DIV D/E:** Billy's Island will continue flanking and backing to the south at a moderate intensity.

**DIV M/N:** This area will be very active today. Winds will push smoke across containment lines. Expect spotting to occur when this happens. The control lines will be tested today due to high winds and low humidity.


Major Hazards & Risks: Extreme Fire Behavior, WUI, Heavy Equipment

**Fire Behavior:** More <u>Extreme Fire Behavior</u> expected over the fire area today due to, a dry cold front passage, high temps, wind gusts, and continued very dry fuel. Remember to have **LCES** in place before engaging. Set Management Action Points and be prepared to disengage and reassess early if necessary.

WUI: Anticipate incident and public traffic. Avoid congestion and have an adequate escape route. Make sure the structure is defensible and there are adequate safety zones for personnel and equipment. Assure adequate water source. Identify and mitigate hazardous materials and fuel tanks. Be aware of and avoid powerlines. If you cannot address all of the above do not commit to stay and protect the structure.

**Heavy Equipment:** There is lots of equipment working in and around the fire including very congested areas. Use spotters while backing. Park vehicles so transports, engines and water tenders can get past you on all roads. Know your travel routes, both capacity and clearances. **Obey bridge rating signs**. Equipment boss needed to assist in safe operations. **Stay clear of equipment work areas** – a minimum of 2.5 tree lengths.

**Speak Up:** If you **see something say something**. Whether it is stopping an unsafe act, letting your co-worker know that they don't look well, or maybe you're not feeling well. Speak up and avoid a potentially dangerous or advanced medical situation.

#### **IWI IC Responsibilities:**

- Take charge of the scene inform the Division Supervisor and Communications that you are the IWI IC and establish radio communications (frequencies, channels). Identify the emergency name Division A medical, Fish Meadows medical, Highway 21 accident.
- Assign or begin patient assessment (9 Line) and first aid. Request additional medical resources on division/branch or across incident. Transmit 9 Line patient information to Communications.
- Determine patient transportation through consultation with line medical personnel and Medical Unit Leader. Consider transportation time, risk to personnel, destination facility and available operational resources. If air transport is chosen, implement the plan for alternative transportation in the event aircraft cannot complete the mission. Order transportation resources through Communications as early as possible.
- Notify Communications as resources arrive and any patient status changes. Names of injured or deceased individuals will not be transmitted on the radio.
- Initiate documentation for future investigation; if a line safety officer is available, assign them to lead documentation. Do not move deceased individuals, gear or personal effects except to accomplish rescue work or protect the safety of others. Obtain written documentation of witnesses. The Unit Log, ICS 214, may be used for the initial documentation, but a subsequent narrative will be required.
- As appropriate, conduct an After Action Review to determine successes, areas to improve and lessons learned.

#### **Media Interviews**

We encourage you to talk to the media if you are approached by a reporter. Feel free to talk about what you are doing on the fires and refer the reporter to an information officer if you are asked questions that are not in your lane. Here are some media tips from the professionals. Find more on page 95 of your Incident Response Pocket Guide.

#### If a reporter approaches you, ask:

- What is the story about?
- Who else have you talked to?
- What did they say?
- Are you talking to anyone else?
- What is your deadline? (Buy time so you can prepare.)

# To be persuasive, a message must:

- Be directed to an audience (the reporter is not the audience.)
- Communicate a benefit or relevance to the audience.
- Reinforce your "brand."

A reporter interview is not a conversation.


Say only what you want to say.

- Know what the story is about before the interview.
- Prepare messages in advance.
- Anticipate likely questions.
- Give the headline first.
- Repeat your key messages.
- Keep it simple.
- Be brief. Say it with conviction.
- Tell the truth.
