### **DISCUSSION:**

Patchy fog will be possible once again around sunrise and shortly after. Otherwise, the area of high pressure that has been dominating of late is showing signs of finally weakening somewhat. This will allow the atmosphere to continue to moisten up. With minimum humidity only expected to drop into the mid to upper 30s. Winds will stay out of the ESE at 10 mph or less with a few higher gusts possible in the afternoon. Temperatures will continue to be warm.

**FUEL ASSUMPTIONS:** The major fuel types found in the West Mims Fire are fuel model SH6 (Brush), Fire Behavior Prediction System Fuel model 7 (Southern Rough) and fuel model 8 (Timber litter). High risk fuels include pine plantations with palmetto/gallberry understory (FM7). Current fuel conditions are favorable for very active fire behavior within all fuel types. Expect all fuels to burn readily, including those that appear green. Reburn is occurring in areas where needle cast from scorch has occurred.

**WEATHER SUMMARY**: Patchy ground fog early, otherwise partly cloudy.

WIND (20 FT): ESE 6 to 10 mph with gusts to 15 in the afternoon.

MAX TEMPERATURES: 91-95 MIN RH: 35-40%

LAL: 1 CHANCE OF RAIN: 0% AMOUNT: 0% MAX DISPERSION:70

MIXING HEIGHT:6200 TRANSPORT WINDS: SE 15 mph

General Fire Behavior Forecast: Drought conditions persist across the fire area. Live fuel moistures continue to be low making the live shrubs and trees available to burn. Fire will easily spread into the canopy when ladder fuels are present; expect long range spotting when this occurs. Be very cautious when critical fire behavior thresholds are exceeded. When thresholds are exceeded fires will become very resistant to control with ground resources alone. Aerial resources will be required. Potential exists for rapid development and growth on any new starts.

### **Critical fire behavior thresholds:**

Temp >90°, RH < 40%, Dispersion index greater than 60

**Specific:** Branch 1 and 2 (west side) have the highest potential for fire activity due to east winds Some reburn activity in the Billy's Island/Honey Island area yesterday. Expect that to continue. As fuel conditions become more favorable for active burning expect the swampy areas that did not burn to heat back up.

-Branch 3 and 4 (east side) - Potential for re-burn returns. Unburned pockets of interior fuels could begin to consume as well. Dozer berms, silviculture piles and other heavy's will continue to hold heat and be a potential spot producer. Ground fire was found near Division Yankee/Zulu break yesterday. Expect that to continue.

-Initial Attack should plan for activity. New fires have potential to develop deceptively quickly. Those divisions with ongoing salvage logging should consider initial attack potential from that equipment.

**AIR OPERATIONS:** Patchy fog is likely once again. Expect aviation to be affected early, but should clear out by mid morning.

FIRE BEHAVIOR SAFETY: Make sure that if you are working in the black – that it is GOOD black. Black with shrub component remaining might not be as safe as it appears. Potential for reburn should be evaluated.

Reference: 1 chain = 66 feet, 20 chains = .25 mile, 40 chains = .50 mile, 60 chains = .75 mile, 80 chains = 1 Mile

Obey all posted speed limits, <u>WEAR YOUR SEATBELTS</u> and <u>ALWAYS USE A SPOTTER</u> when backing. Sleepiness and driving is a dangerous combination.....STAY ALERT....ARRIVE ALIVE.....

**Communications:** There are areas of communication dead zones especially in Branch I, Divs D,E,F. Mitigate those by using mobile repeaters or cell phones. Don't engage in active fire unless you have **L-C**ommunications-**E-S** in place.

**Fire Behavior:** Fire behavior and activity has continued to be minimal on all areas of the fire. There is still an abundant amount of heat on portions of the fire, specifically the southeast corner. Continue to be diligent observing weather patterns and forecast daily.

**Speak Up:** If you see something say something. Whether it is stopping an unsafe act, letting your co-worker know that they don't look well, or maybe you're not feeling well. Speak up and avoid a potentially dangerous or advanced medical situation.

- Assign or begin patient assessment (9 Line) and first aid. Request additional medical resources on division/branch or across incident. Transmit 9 Line patient information to Communications.
- Determine patient transportation through consultation with line medical personnel and Medical Unit Leader. Consider transportation time, risk to personnel, destination facility and available operational resources. If air transport is chosen, implement the plan for alternative transportation in the event aircraft cannot complete the mission. Order transportation resources through Communications as early as possible.
- Notify Communications as resources arrive and any patient status changes. Names of injured or deceased individuals will not be transmitted on the radio.
- Initiate documentation for future investigation; if a line safety officer is available, assign them to lead documentation. Do not move deceased individuals, gear or personal effects except to accomplish rescue work or protect the safety of others. Obtain written documentation of witnesses. The Unit Log, ICS 214, may be used for the initial documentation, but a subsequent narrative will be required.
- As appropriate, conduct an After Action Review to determine successes, areas to improve and lessons learned.


## Sea Breeze and Wildfire

#### What is it?

Sea breeze is wind that forms over a large body of water and blows inland.

#### What causes it?

Land heats up faster than ocean water. During the day, hot land air rises, causing low pressure at the surface. Cool ocean air is under high pressure. The movement of air from high pressure (ocean) to low pressure (land) creates wind that blows inland, usually in the afternoon when the land reaches its maximum heating.



#### What are its effects on wildfire behavior?

The strength of a sea breeze and how far inland it travels depends on the land/ocean temperature differential. If an easterly Atlantic sea breeze, for example, is strong enough to reach the fire area, the density difference between hot and cold air masses creates a boundary called a sea-breeze front, which is essentially a shallow cold front. At this boundary, winds shift and thuderstorms can develop. The Okefenokee is close enough to the Atlantic Ocean and Gulf of Mexico to be affected by both sea breezes. If two sea breezes were to converge over the fire area, the resulting wind shifts and potential thunderstorms would be more intense.


