FUEL ASSUMPTIONS: The major fuel types found in the West Mims Fire are fuel model SH6 (Brush), Fire Behavior Prediction System Fuel model 7 (Southern Rough) and fuel model 8 (Timber litter). High risk fuels include pine plantations with palmetto/gallberry understory (FM7). Current fuel conditions are favorable for very active fire behavior within all fuel types. Expect all fuels to burn readily, including those that appear green. Reburn is occurring in areas where needle cast from scorch has occurred.

WEATHER SUMMARY: Patchy fog possible early, otherwise mostly clear.

WIND (20 FT): SE 6 to 10 mph. Gusts up to 15 mph in the afternoon.

MAX TEMPERATURES: 91-95

General Fire Behavior Forecast: Drought condition persist across the fire area. Live fuel moistures continue to be low making the live scrubs and trees available to burn. Fire will easily spread into the canopy when latter fuels are present; expect long range spotting when this occurs. Be very cautious when critical fire behavior thresholds are exceeded. When thresholds are exceeded fires will become very resistant to control with ground resources and will require the combination of aerial and ground resources to be effective in controlling fires.

Critical fire behavior thresholds: Temp >90°, RH < 40%, Dispersion index greater than 60

Specific: Branch 1 and 2 (west side) have the highest potential for fire activity due to east winds. As the weather conditions become more favorable for active burning expect the swampy areas that did not burn to heat back up. This will increase the potential for spotting in those areas.

Branch 3 and 4 (east side) - Potential for re-burn returns. Unburned pockets of interior fuels could begin to consume as well.

Initial Attack should plan for activity. New fires have potential to develop deceptively quickly.

One hour fine dead fuel moisture will drop to 4%. 10 hour fuels are ranging 8%. Extensive mop up is required.

AIR OPERATIONS: Fog may limit flying in the morning. Clearing conditions by mid-morning.

FIRE BEHAVIOR SAFETY: Unfamiliar with weather and local factors influencing fire behavior. Many of you are unfamiliar with fire behavior in the South and what the local knowledge is on thresholds, trigger points, etc. If you don't know ASK and LEARN!

Reference: 1 chain = 66 feet, 20 chains = .25 mile, 40 chains = .50 mile, 60 chains = .75 mile, 80 chains = 1 Mile

Major Hazards & Risks: Driving, Fire Behavior, WUI, Equipment

Driving: Drive the speed limit. If you are uncomfortable driving the speed limit, move over to a safe area and allow other motorists to go by, preventing traffic jams. **Backing** is a risky operation so get some help. Passengers are responsible to get out and spot any problems for the driver.

Fire Behavior: Weather will continue to dry fuels, increasing fire behavior until the weekend's rain event. The probability for ignition will be very high today, so keep your eyes open for multiple spots as you engage in suppression actions. **Always establish LCES and keep it current.**

Wildland Urban Interface: Wildland Urban Interface may be found on this incident. Hazardous materials such as pesticides, fertilizers, fuel and old appliances are examples. Small barrels of food substances such as peanut products are NOT hazardous, but could hurt your intestinal tract.

Equipment: Moving equipment has momentum that can make a major dent or major injury. **Operators must be sure their route is clear of people and vehicles.** Do you have enough room to turn or park? By-standers should help spot to prevent potential accidents and speak up quickly.



Motor Vehicle Accident Protocol

- Assess need for first aid & get help.
- Notify your supervisor (DIVS, SITL, etc.), safety officer & section chief ASAP - within 1 hour.
- Supervisor complete documentation with photos & give to comp/claims.
- Determine if repairs are needed, get approvals & make arrangements.

IWI IC Responsibilities:										

IWI IC Responsibilities:

- Take charge of the scene inform the Division Supervisor and Communications that you are the IWI IC and establish radio communications (frequencies, channels). Identify the emergency name Division A medical, Fish Meadows medical, Highway 21 accident.
- Assign or begin patient assessment (9 Line) and first aid. Request additional medical resources on division/branch or across incident. Transmit 9 Line patient information to Communications.
- Determine patient transportation through consultation with line medical personnel and Medical Unit Leader. Consider transportation time, risk to personnel, destination facility and available operational resources. If air transport is chosen, implement the plan for alternative transportation in the event aircraft cannot complete the mission. Order transportation resources through Communications as early as possible.
- Notify Communications as resources arrive and any patient status changes. Names of injured or deceased individuals will not be transmitted on the radio.
- Initiate documentation for future investigation; if a line safety officer is available, assign them to lead documentation. Do not move deceased individuals, gear or personal effects except to accomplish rescue work or protect the safety of others. Obtain written documentation of witnesses. The Unit Log, ICS 214, may be used for the initial documentation, but a subsequent narrative will be required.
- As appropriate, conduct an After Action Review to determine successes, areas to improve and lessons learned.




