 Confine all new fires (new starts or breakouts) within the Okefenokee National Wildlife Refuge and/or inside the swamp edge break. Fight fire aggressively and suppress all fire outside the swamp edge boundary, preventing fires from outside the break from entering the refuge while minimizing damage to private timberlands and improvements.

Major Hazards & Risks	Driving, Initial Attack

**Driving Safety**: To be a safe driver you have to want to be one. Take a good hard look at your driving habits. Are you training yourself to do the right things the right way:


- Walk around complete
- Seat belt fastened
- Mirrors adjusted
- Headlights On

Many things can lure our attention away from driving such as: fatigue, eating and drinking, reading directions and maps, writing, cell phone and radio use, conversation within the vehicle and music. Minimize these distractions or safely pull over.

**Initial Attack Safety**: Having a good size up is important in order to get a good idea of what problems exist and what resources may be needed for effective firefighting.

- Size up and Report
- Consider responder safety, road conditions, nearby public roads, weather conditions, fire behavior, escape routes and safety zones. Implement actions and Risk Management Process (IRPG pg. 1 green section).
- When operating on or near a roadway: Wear a high visibility reflective vest or other high visibility clothing. Secure the scene and provide or request assistance for traffic control. Park your vehicle to provide a protective barricade for you and your crew. Position it so that an inattentive driver will hit your vehicle and not your crew. Your vehicle is expendable, you are not.

Communication is essential on an incident, and basically throughout life. Unfortunately, the words that come out of our mouths end up sounding like wing-dings to the person we are speaking to. You don't mean for that to happen, but it does.

Good communication skills require two things - listening and speaking. A wise man once told me that we have 2 ears and 1 mouth for a reason - to listen twice as much as we speak. And if you notice, our ears always stay open, while our mouths have a hinge so it can be closed.

So, if someone is getting on your nerves, try to talk to them. I mean, really talk to them. No yelling, screaming, cussing or hollering. Take the time to listen to them twice as much as you speak. You never know, you could end up making a new friend!

-Determine patient transportation through consultation with line medical personnel and Medical Unit Leader. -Order transportation resources through Communications as early as possible.

-Notify Communications as resources arrive and any patient status changes.

-Names of injured or deceased individuals will not be transmitted on the radio.

-Initiate documentation for future investigation; if a line safety officer is available, assign them to lead documentation.

-Conduct an After Action Review to determine successes, areas to improve and lessons learned


