### **DISCUSSION:**

The stretch of unsettled weather in Southeast Georgia and Northeast Florida continues today. Scattered showers and storms are expected to develop over the region in the afternoon and carry into the evening before dissipating. Temperatures around 90 are expected with minimum RH values around 45 percent. Winds will be light and generally southerly, except where the seabreeze reaches, in which case winds will turn easterly and increase to 5-10 mph.

**FUEL ASSUMPTIONS:** Fuel types include, brush/southern rough fuels, shrub-grass fuels in young plantation pine and the swamp, timber litter (scorched pine needle reburn fuels) and heavy shrub fuels in bayhead/drainage fuels. The high risk fuel is the pine plantation overstory with the palmetto/gallberry brush understory. Live canopy fuel moistures in pines and brush are below average and will support active crown fire when critical fire weather and below normal fuel dryness is present. Current fuel dryness as represented by KBDI and ERC G is above normal. Current fuel conditions are favorable for very active fire behavior within all fuel types. Expect all fuels to burn readily, including those that appear green.

KBDI: 625 (92nd percentile), ERC-G: 34 (75th percentile)

**WEATHER SUMMARY**: Partly Cludy with scattered showers and thunderstorms. Easterly seabreeze development in the afternoon.

WIND (20 FT): Light variable early becoming South 4-9 mph in afternoon.

### Large fire growth on May 5, 2017: Fire Environment Conditions present for fire run that threatened St. George.

Fuel dryness and fire weather combined to produce significant fire growth of 18,000 acres with an initial run that was 9 miles in length. This growth initiated in swamp brush fuels east of Soldier Camp and burned out of the refuge into high risk pine plantation fuels. Fuel dryness was extremely dry with KBDI over the 97<sup>th</sup> percentile at 720. ERC G was at the 85<sup>th</sup> percentile at 37. Wind was the major weather driver of this fire growth. Peak windspeeds at Jacksonville Airport were sustained from the west at 28 mph with gusts to 40 mph. Max temperature was 75. Minimum RH was 30%. Burning index G was over the 97<sup>th</sup> percentile at 49. Average rate of spread was estimated at just over 1 mph. Active crown fire or running crown fire produced spotting out to 1 mile.

Specific: All Branches: Surface fuels will remain dry and available to burn in areas that did not receive significant rainfall. Piles and muck fuels will continue to hold heat and smolder. Passing thunderstorms will bring new starts and influence surface fire behavior, particularly in young pine plantations, increasing the potential for torching and possible short crown runs in plantations. Erratic winds will cause head direction shifts during passage of thunderstorms. In areas receiving significant precipitation, fuel moistures will increase and fire will retreat into the ground fuels, particularly in the muck soils. Use precipitation to aid mopping up of heat sources.

AIR OPERATIONS: Initial attack activity could increase the need for air operations. Maintain good communications with other aircraft and ground crews. Powerful afternoon thunderstorms could impede air operations.

### FIRE BEHAVIOR SAFETY:

Don't become complacent about the potential fire behavior in both the fire and the surrounding area. Fuels continue to dry, raising the potential for active fire behavior without strong wind influence.


**INCIDENT:** West Mims Fire DATE: Friday, June 2, 2017

Major Hazards & Risks Heavy Equipment, Head lights, Speak up

**Heavy Equipment:** There is lots of equipment working in and around the fire including very congested areas. Use spotters while backing. Park vehicles so transports, engines and water tenders can get past you on all roads. Know the capacities and clearances of your travel routes. **Obey bridge rating signs**. Equipment boss needed to assist in safe operations. **Stay clear of equipment work areas** – a minimum of 2.5 tree lengths.

**Headlight Use:** With all of the logging traffic and other non-fire traffic, it is imperative that **we drive with our lights on** to make sure we are visible to oncoming drivers. This applies to heavy equipment as well as highway vehicles. If your vehicle is newer, having your lights on "Auto" doesn't mean they will be on when the sun is out. Turn your headlights to "On" to make sure you are covered.

**Speak Up:** If you see something say something. Whether it is stopping an unsafe act, letting your co-worker know that they don't look well, or maybe you're not feeling well. Speak up and avoid a potentially dangerous or advanced medical situation.

# UNFAMILIAR WITH WEATHER AND LOCAL FACTORS INFLUENCING FIRE BEHAVIOR

Does the operational period plan give you adequate weather and information? What kinds of weather forecasts can you get? What other weather or local information do you look for in the shift plan? Can you get information from resources that have been on the fire? What questions will you ask of the crew that you are replacing? Is there any other way to obtain information? List common sources of information on weather and local factors (Examples: Web based weather Activity Planner, Point Forecast Matrix, NOAA Internet Briefing) To reduce risks:

- ☐ Base all actions on current and expected fire behavior.
- □ Post lookouts.
- ☐ Establish escape routes and safety zones.
- ☐ Take extra caution! Discuss a fire where you relied on information from the local unit (perhaps where your fire knowledge and experience was very different from how they did things—southeast or Alaska).
- □ Recognize and report visual indicators (clouds, WX obs., cold front passage, inversion breaking

- -Names of injured or deceased individuals will not be transmitted on the radio.
- -Initiate documentation for future investigation; if a line safety officer is available, assign them to lead documentation.
- -Conduct an After Action Review to determine successes, areas to improve and lessons learned


