#### **DISCUSSION:**

Deep, moist low level southerly flow will continue to bring moisture in over the incident today and produce widespread showers and thunderstorms. The thunderstorms will produce heavy rain, and storms may produce strong wind gusts. A cold front will pass the incident this evening with continued widespread showers and thunderstorms. Storms may be strong, especially along the front. Drier weather arrives Thursday.

**FUEL ASSUMPTIONS:** Fuel types include mixed grass, brush and timber types. The high risk fuel type is grass/palmetto/gallberry brush understory, particularly in the early/mid rotation pine plantations.

Fuels are beginning to recover moisture in most areas of the fire due to recent rains. Current fuel conditions are not favorable for active fire behavior. Active crown fire in brush and pine canopy is not expected over the next two operational periods.

# LARGE FIRE GROWTH FIRE ENVIRONMENT CONDITIONS PRESENT DURING FIRE RUN THAT THREATENED ST GEORGE ON MAY 5<sup>th</sup>, 2017.

Fuel dryness and fire weather combined to produce significant fire growth of 18,000 acres with an initial run that was 9 miles in length. Growth initiated in swamp brush fuels east of Soldier Camp Island and burned out of the refuge into pine plantation fuels.

Fuel Moistures: 1hr FM= 5% 10 hr. FM= 7% 100 hr. FM= 14% Live Woody= 101% Herbaceous= 119%

**SPECIFIC:** All Branches: The current fire weather forecast is not favorable for active fire behavior, and no significant fire spread events are expected during the current operational period. Surface fuels are nearly saturated with moisture from recent rains. In highly protected areas piles and/or organic soil fuels will continue to smolder.

#### Task

- Repair Sapp's Prairie to original state.
- Patrol and mop up fuels appropriate to fuel type and anticipated weather and fire behavior.

LUCAS MINTON (T)

- · Respond to any new starts within the division.
- Create or improve fireline around logging debris in coordination with logging operators.

#### **Purpose**

- · Return Wilderness to original state.
- · Keep fire east of swamp edge fire break.
- Keep fire north of GA 94/ FL 2

#### **End State**

- Sapp's Prairie to original state.
- Fire is contained by adequate control line to reduce threat to escape; minimizing damage to private timberlands, private lands, and other resource values at risk.

## 7. Special Instructions:

Ensure LCES is in place before operations begin and stay hydrated. Drive defensively and with lights on at all times. Identify escape routes. Logging operations are continuing. Stay clear of cutting areas. Please be mindful of logging operations that will be ongoing. Ensure that all personnel stay clear of felling operations. Pay attention for potential reburn in logging area. Work with Gilyard Logging foreman on any suppression actions within the logging area.

Use caution when working around logging operations.

## <u>Suppression Repair</u> General Information

Suppression repair is underway in some areas of the Fire. While conducting suppression repair activities, please consider the following:

**General Description:** Repair of suppression constructed "fire breaks" is necessary to avoid excessive soil erosion and restore natural landscape surface water flows. While some fire breaks were created in previously undisturbed areas, most fire breaks were created by blading and/or widening existing roads or fire breaks.

<u>Location (Suitable) Sites:</u> All Divisions will have some level of suppression repair. Fire personnel are currently mapping repair needs. Branch and Division Supervisors will be provided with maps detailing suppression repair needs.

<u>Ownership Type:</u> Suppression repair may be needed on Okefenokee NWR, John M. Bethea State Forest, Osceola National Forest, and Georgia Private Lands. It is important to know where you are working as *repair specifications may vary by landowner type*.

<u>Coordination of Repair with READs:</u> Suppression repair work should be done under the direction of Branch or Division Supervisors and done in coordination with Resource Advisors to assure cultural and natural resource concerns have been addressed.

<u>Completion of Repair:</u> When specific suppression repairs are completed a READ should be contacted for final verification and documentation in Arc Collector.

If any type of **cultural resources or artifacts** are discovered during suppression repair activities, **stop work immediately** and contact a Resource Advisor or Archaeologist.

## Suppression Repair Standards

 Permanent Firebreaks: Berms and other excess soil displaced by firebreak construction should be pulled back into the disturbed area and returned to the original contour or pre-suppression grade. These lines will be identified by the appropriate landowner.

Firebreaks Constructed In Previously Undisturbed Areas: Repair of suppression constructed firebreaks is necessary to avoid excessive soil erosion, restore pre-fire landscape surface water flow patterns, and to facilitate movement of wildlife where necessary. Berms, vegetation and other excess soil displaced by firebreak construction should be pulled back into the disturbed area and returned to the original contour. Logs and other debris that are near the firebreak should be placed on the repaired firebreak to deter vehicle traffic.

Intermittent Stream Crossings: Firebreaks which cross drainages will be identified and inventoried for necessary repairs. Large debris piles located in these areas will be removed or spread away from wetlands or streams. Where fire lines cross stream channels, it is important to minimize soil movement into the stream and to prevent the stream from cutting a new channel in the firebreak. Use no more than 12-inch-high berms to keep the stream in its banks and direct soil movement away from the channel at crossings and approaches.

**Perennial Stream or Canal Crossings:** Guidance for repair will be provided by Resource Specialists.

## 2. Point Locations:

- a) Incident Facilities: Site specific restoration will be needed
- b) Previously Undisturbed Areas: Pull soil and vegetation from berms back onto the disturbed area. Some areas may require disposal or scattering excess piled vegetation in adjacent areas.
- **3. Roads:** Roads identified for repair will need to be graded or reshaped to be brought back to pre-suppression condition.
  - a) Clean out, repair or replace damaged road culverts. Old damaged culverts should be removed from site and disposed of properly.
  - b) Repair damage to chip sealed roads and paved roads
  - c) Repair or replace damaged closure gates and locks.
  - d) Repair or replace damaged signs damaged by fire suppression activities.
  - e) Cut and fell trees identified as hazards along public access roads or trails.
  - f) Large piles of vegetative debris on or near roads should be broken up, mulched, or chipped as appropriate.

- -Names of injured or deceased individuals will not be transmitted on the radio.
- -Initiate documentation for future investigation; if a line safety officer is available, assign them to lead documentation.
- -Conduct an After Action Review to determine successes, areas to improve and lessons learned


