.DISCUSSION...

Much of the area north of I-10 is now outlined in an elevated risk for critical fire conditions per SPC Fire Weather Outlook for Wednesday. Additionally, there is a Red Flag Warning in effect for most of the area save lower Vermilion to lower St. Martin. Minimum RH values are expected to fall to 25 percent, with northerly wind gusts possibly as high as 20 to 25 mph.

Similar conditions can be expected on Thursday and Friday. This weekend, winds will begin to return out of the south with an increase in showers and thunderstorms along with RH across the entire area.

The cornerstone of safety is to take time to assess the job and its environment. In order to encourage this principle, please consider using the “**STOP**” acronym to act as a reminder to pursue all jobs in a safe manner

TRANSFER OF COMMAND

Risks to fireline personnel increase significantly during transfer of command periods regardless of the size or complexity of the incident. There is a high potential for fatalities, serious injuries, or incidents with potential during transfer of command periods (some have occurred in the past). Be proactive in mitigating the risks by proper implementation of LCES—Lookout, Communications, Escape Routes, and Safety Zones.

- Factors for increased risks to fireline personnel during transition periods include:
 - No, or poor, briefing of incoming personnel
 - Lack of fire weather and behavior information, both forecast and observed
 - Communications; face-to-face briefings may not be possible and radio frequencies may be overextended and/or changing due to the increased demands on the system.
 - Initial attack resources may not have checked-in and the Incident Commander may not be aware of the number, type and location of all resources.
 - Location of safety zones and escape routes may not be known and communicated to all resources.
- Mitigation actions to take:
 - Lookouts: Post and maintain your own lookouts.
 - Communications: Maintain existing communications with your own and adjacent resources, as well as your original supervisor, while you are developing communications with incoming adjacent resources and your new supervisor.
 - Escape routes and safety zones: Identify escape routes and assure incoming resources are aware of their locations; be aware that your original escape routes and safety zones may no longer be accessible due to changing fire behavior or your increased distance from them.

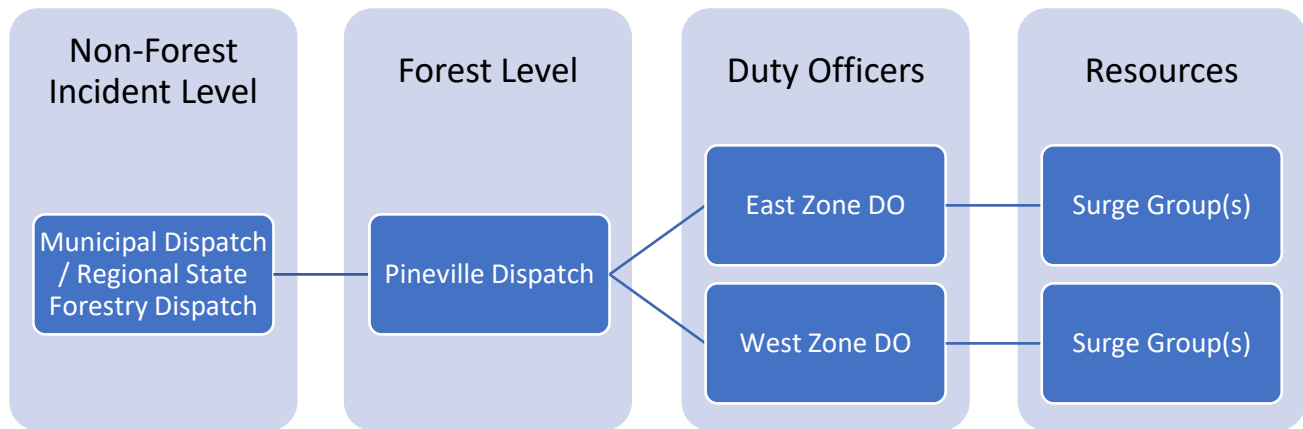

- Communication from Municipal Dispatch or Regional State Dispatch should be done by telephone.
- Pineville Dispatch should contact the Zone DO's via the appropriate repeater for their location.
- Interagency communications may be difficult. Most resources should have Region 8 Fire in their radios. For initial incoming resources, look to Region 8 Fire for communications. In the event that non-federal resources do not have any radio channels in common, IC's should consider having a representative of the resource with them at all times to ensure communications with resources outside of the communication chain.

Resources assigned to LALIC Support and the Ida fire are requested to submit all finance documents electronically to the email listed below.

Please email electronic copies of the following documents as applicable:

- Contract/Agreement/State Cooperative Agreement
- Casual Hire Form (ADs)
- Resource Order
- Crew Manifest

The preferred method of turning in CTR's, Shift Tickets, or other associated Time documents is direct to our Finance email.

- CTRs and Shift Tickets should be submitted at a minimum, every other day.
- Justifications are required in the remarks when posting Time without meal breaks.
- Hazard Pay is required to be justified in the remarks, such as: "Firefighting on an uncontrolled Fireline."
- Taking a picture of your signed CTR/Shift Ticket is perfectly acceptable.
- Our Finance email does not have an auto reply.

Fillable PDF CTR/Shift Ticket:

Acceptable PDF's- Below is a QR Code linked to electronic CTR and Shift Ticket templates. However, we accept any version that is signable and has all of the required fields. Be mindful of what browser you open the PDF in, downloading the PDF form tends to prevent filling and signature issues.

Option 1 - Resource fills out CTR/Shift Ticket and e-mails to supervisor for signature. Supervisor digitally signs CTR then e-mails signed copy back to resource AND resource forwards to the Finance email.

Option 2 - Resource fills out CTR, supervisor (if comfortable) signs directly on same device. Resource e-mails CTR directly to the finance email.

Picture of Hard Copy CTR/Shift Ticket:

Option 1 - Resource fills out hard copy CTR, supervisor signs hard copy. Resource takes a picture of the signed document, reviews picture to ensure it's legible, and emails to Finance.

Option 2 - Resource fills out hard copy CTR, snaps a picture of CTR and e-mails/texts to supervisor. Supervisor digitally signs CTR then e-mails signed copy back to resource AND Finance.

IWI IC Responsibilities – Division Group Supervisor or Point of Contact

- Take charge of the scene and identify/determine who is in charge of assessing and treating the patient.
- Use the Medical Incident Report (in IRPG or IAP) to relay critical information regarding patient assessment, transportation, and resource needs.
- Coordinate the request for transportation and/or other resources based on patient assessment.
- Ensure that information about patient assessment, transportation or other resource needs is transmitted directly over the radio on command and by phone (911).
- The Incident Commander, Medical Unit Leader, Safety Officer and Communications unit will be notified promptly. The IC will ensure that all remaining command and general staff are notified.
- All incident personnel will be instructed by the appropriate chain of command position to clear the designated radio channel for “emergency traffic” related only to the emergency situation. If the chain of command individuals are not available, the highest qualified person on scene will broadcast “emergency radio traffic.”
