WEATHER/CLIMATOLOGY DISCUSSION:

Check the daily fire weather forecast for the NWS zone that you are working in.

Outlook as of 1600 on 9/23/2023

Moisture levels will begin to increase Sunday night as an upper system approaches the area. Monday and Tuesday may see a little higher humidity levels, but much of the area is unlikely to see significant rainfall. However, dry air moves back into the area Wednesday through Friday and afternoon relative humidity will once again drop into the 30-35% range.

Sea breezes that bring a sharp wind shift and gusts as high as 20-30 mph later in the afternoon are possible along the coast of Louisiana and Mississippi.

Any lightning will pose a risk of lightning-ignited wildfires.

FIRE BEHAVIOR DISCUSSION:

A Fire and Fuels behavior Advisory has been issued for Louisiana and Mississippi. Very hot temperatures are forecast to dry out fuels and increase ERC values in the MS and LA over the next couple weeks. Widespread KBDIs above 700 are indicative of the continuing drought throughout MS and LA.

Expect moderate to extreme fire behavior with the potential for a rapid transition to crown fire in brush and timber fuels.

Expected Fire Behavior for Sunday (09/24) through Tuesday (09/26):

GS3-Grass/Shrub: ROS **15 to 47 CPH, FL 6-10 feet**. Expect FL in excess of 10 feet and ROS exceeding <u>48 CPH in</u> areas dominated by denser grass fuels.

7-Southern Rough: ROS **13 to 38 CPH, FL 5-7 feet.** Expect passive crown fire. <u>Active crown fire possible especially where terrain and wind align and from outflow winds near isolated thunderstorms.</u>

TU2-Timber: ROS **5 to 15 CPH, FL 3-4 feet.** Expect passive crown fire. <u>Active crown fire possible especially where</u> terrain and wind align and from outflow winds near isolated thunderstorms.

Spotting up to $\frac{1}{4}$ of a mile away has routinely been reported on recent fires, including small initial attack fires. The peak probability of Ignition is 70. PI > 70% HIGH PROBABILITY OF SPOT FIRES

ROS-Rate of Spread, CPH-Chains per Hour (1 chain = 66 feet) 40 chains per hour is .5 miles

In the event conditions change forecasts may need to be revised. Major changes may include,

- 1) Major change in weather forecast
- 2) Widespread rains
- 3) Observed fire behavior is not well represented by forecast

In the event reassessment criteria is met, request a spot weather forecast and an updated fire behavior forecast.

SAFETY

1) Outflow from thunderstorm can create wind shifts and unexpected increase wind speeds. Thunderstorms can blow wildfires out of containment, change the fire's direction and/or cause a significant change in the wildfire's intensity and behavior. Thunderstorms have been a direct factor in the death and serious injury to many firefighters.

- Include your cell phone number on CTR and/or Shift Tickets in remarks.

<u>Partial Payments</u> – VIPR Resources should have an interim invoice submitted after 14 days. Please email lodging receipts while assigned to the incident(s) to finance to complete and interim invoice if extending.

<u>Demob</u> – Please notify finance when emailing time documents for your last operational shift to close out time.







Transfer of Command

This incident has gone through a Transfer of Command the risk for the personnel Increase Significantly.

Here some factors that will increase the risk:

- No or poor briefing of incoming or staying personnel.
- Not knowing who is in command.
- Face -face briefing may not be possible and radio frequencies could be changed.
- Some resources have not checked in and new Command staff may not be aware of the number, type, and locations of all resources.

Mitigation actions:

- Utilize the IRPG briefing check list.
- All resources know who their immediate supervisor is before engaging.

Safety Checklist

- LCES must be established & known to ALL firefighters BEFORE needed.
- Know the major areas of safety concern on fires: firelines, transportation, weather.
- Participate in crew briefings before, during, and after each operational period.
- Drink enough water to replace fluids lost through perspiration. Drink at least one quart of water per hour.
- Drive with headlights on and watch your speed.

IWI IC Responsibilities – Division Group Supervisor or Point of Contact

- Take charge of the scene inform the Division Supervisor and LICC that you are the IWI IC and establish radio communications (frequencies, channels). Identify the emergency name Division A medical, etc.
- Assign or begin patient assessment (Medical Incident Report MIR) and first aid. Request additional medical resources on division/branch or across incident. Transmit MIR patient information to Communications.
- Determine patient transportation through consultation with communications and 911 when needed. Consider transportation time, risk to personnel, destination facility and available operational resources. If air transport is chosen, implement the plan for alternative transportation in the event aircraft cannot complete the mission. Order transportation resources through Communications as early as possible.
- Notify Communications as resources arrive and any patient status changes. Names of injured or deceased individuals will not be transmitted on the radio.
- Initiate documentation for future investigation; if a line safety officer is available, assign them to lead documentation. Do not move deceased individuals, gear or personal effects except to accomplish rescue work or protect the safety of others. Obtain written documentation of witnesses. Unit Log, ICS 214, may be used for initial documentation, but a narrative will be required.
- As appropriate, conduct an After-Action Review to determine successes, areas to improve and lessons learned.
