3. Objective(s):

- 1. All operations will be conducted with safety of the public and firefighters in mind. Protection of life and property is your highest priority task. When in doubt, sacrifice acres rather than firefighter and public safety.
- 2. Provide public information regarding fire danger to maintain good awareness of the risk and hazards to the public. Coordinate with LDAF Public Information Officer at (225) 975-7532 or presssecretary@ldaf.la.gov and State Fire Marshall's Public Affairs Director at (225) 620-5115 or ashley.rodrigue@la.gov.
- 3. Manage the human resources assigned to fire incident in a manner that promotes mutual respect and is consistent with interagency human resource objectives. The team will handle EEO complaints in consultation with LDAF Human Resources involving personnel attached to the team.
- 4. Continue partnership and coordination with the appropriate LDAF, State Fire Marshall, GOHSEP, and local public safety officials.
- 5. Manage incident in a cost effective manner.

4. Operational Period Command Emphasis:

Stop, Think, Discuss then Act, and ensure LCES is in place prior to engaging the fires. The Tiger Island, Hwy. 113, Lions Camp Road and Elizabeth Fires receive a strategic, risk-based response, commensurate with the threats and opportunities, and uses the full spectrum of management actions, that consider fire and fuel conditions, weather, values at risk, and resources available.

WEATHER DISCUSSION: As the weather system pulls away from the region today, coverage of showers and storms will be less across fire areas. However, scattered showers and storms are still expected by this afternoon. The main risks from any storms will be brief heavy rain, lightning, and gusty outflow winds. The probability of a wetting rain (0.25"+) drops to 30%. Winds will favor SSE, but be variable at times with occasional wind gusts around 15 mph. Any showers and storms will gradually diminish through the evening with clearing overnight.

WEATHER:Partly cloudy becoming mostly cloudy with scattered showers and thunderstorms.MAX TEMP:94-97°HEAT INDEX:102-106°MIN RH:45-55%PROBABILITY OF PRECIP:50%CHC WTG RAIN:30%LAL:3WINDS (20 feet):SSE 4-8 mph with gusts up to 15 mph. Gusty and erratic outflows from variable directions associated with any storms.MIXING HEIGHT:Weak morning inversion.5,000-6,000 ft during the afternoon.TRANSPORT WIND:S 8-13 mph.

EXTENDED OUTLOOK: THURSDAY- SATURDAY: Thursday through Saturday, daily chances for showers/storms will drop to 10-25% with warming/drying conditions. Southerly and/or southeasterly flow will keep enough moisture streaming north for continued excellent RH recoveries each morning. However, afternoon min RH values will drop back into the 30% range with daily highs around 100 degrees. Winds will generally be light, with occasional wind gusts around 15 mph.



- Return service initially will be the same day or within 24 hours depending on load counts.






IWI IC Responsibilities – Division Group Supervisor or Point of Contact

• Take charge of the scene – inform the Division Supervisor and Tiger Island Communications that you are the IWI IC and establish radio communications (frequencies, channels). Identify the emergency name – Division A medical, etc.

• For backup IWI communication, call the IWI phone: (208) 891-6743.

• Assign or begin patient assessment (Medical Incident Report - MIR) and first aid. Request additional medical resources on division/branch or across incident. Transmit MIR patient information to Communications.

• Determine patient transportation through consultation with line medical personnel and Medical Unit Leader. Consider transportation time, risk to personnel, destination facility and available operational resources. If air transport is chosen, implement the plan for alternative transportation in the event aircraft cannot complete the mission. Order transportation resources through Communications as early as possible.

• Notify Communications as resources arrive and any patient status changes. Names of injured or deceased individuals will not be transmitted on the radio.

• Initiate documentation for future investigation; if a line safety officer is available, assign them to lead documentation. Do not move deceased individuals, gear or personal effects except to accomplish rescue work or protect the safety of others. Obtain written documentation of witnesses. Unit Log, ICS 214, may be used for initial documentation, but a narrative will be required.

• As appropriate, conduct an After Action Review to determine successes, areas to improve and lessons learned.
