3. Objective(s):

- 1. All operations will be conducted with safety of the public and firefighters in mind. Protection of life and property is your highest priority task. When in doubt, sacrifice acres rather than firefighter and public safety.
- 2. Provide public information regarding fire danger to maintain good awareness of the risk and hazards to the public. Coordinate with LDAF Public Information Officer at (225) 975-7532 or presssecretary@ldaf.la.gov and State Fire Marshall's Public Affairs Director at (225) 620-5115 or ashley.rodrigue@la.gov.
- 3. Manage the human resources assigned to fire incident in a manner that promotes mutual respect and is consistent with interagency human resource objectives. The team will handle EEO complaints in consultation with LDAF Human Resources involving personnel attached to the team.
- 4. Continue partnership and coordination with the appropriate LDAF, State Fire Marshall, GOHSEP, and local public safety officials.
- 5. Manage incident in a cost effective manner.

4. Operational Period Command Emphasis:

Stop, Think, Discuss then Act, and ensure LCES is in place prior to engaging the fires. The Tiger Island, Hwy 113, Lions Camp Rd and Elizabeth Fires receive a strategic, risk-based response, commensurate with the threats and opportunities, and uses the full spectrum of management actions, that consider fire and fuel conditions, weather, values at risk, and resources available.

WEATHER DISCUSSION: Expect a warmer and drier afternoon compared to past days with heat indices possibly rising to 107 degrees. While coverage of storms will be less today, an isolated shower or thunderstorm cannot be ruled out. Main risks would be lightning, gusty outflow winds, and brief heavy rain. The winds this afternoon will be variable with occasional wind gusts around 15 mph during peak heating. Any showers and storms will gradually diminish through the evening with clearing overnight.

EXTENDED OUTLOOK: FRIDAY - SUNDAY: A frontal boundary will push through the region Friday and Saturday with showers/storms becoming increasingly likely. Generally scattered storms are anticipated, but the probability could certainly rise over the coming days. Rain chances decrease on Sunday, but isolated activity remains possible. While the afternoons may briefly dry to 30-40% RH, overnight RH recoveries will remain above 85%. Afternoon winds will also continue to be light and variable, with occasional wind gusts to 15 mph.

VENOMOUS SNAKES

Northern Cottonmouths have been spotted on the Tiger Island fire in DIV J but may be expected on all fires.

There are 5 different species of venomous snakes in western Louisiana: Northern Cottonmouth, Eastern Copperhead, Timber Rattlesnake, Pygmy Rattlesnake and Texas Coral Snake. See attached QR code for identification information.

In event of a snakebite, the best treatment is timely medical attention. Remain calm. Contact closest Medical resource, and notify your supervisor.

First Aid includes: Keep the patient still. Remove constrictive jewelry. Clean wound if practical.





- Return service initially will be the same day or within 24 hours depending on load counts.






IWI IC Responsibilities – Division Group Supervisor or Point of Contact

• Take charge of the scene – inform the Division Supervisor and Tiger Island Communications that you are the IWI IC and establish radio communications (frequencies, channels). Identify the emergency name – Division A medical, etc.

• For backup IWI communication, call the IWI phone: (208) 891-6743.

• Assign or begin patient assessment (Medical Incident Report - MIR) and first aid. Request additional medical resources on division/branch or across incident. Transmit MIR patient information to Communications.

• Determine patient transportation through consultation with line medical personnel and Medical Unit Leader. Consider transportation time, risk to personnel, destination facility and available operational resources. If air transport is chosen, implement the plan for alternative transportation in the event aircraft cannot complete the mission. Order transportation resources through Communications as early as possible.

• Notify Communications as resources arrive and any patient status changes. Names of injured or deceased individuals will not be transmitted on the radio.

• Initiate documentation for future investigation; if a line safety officer is available, assign them to lead documentation. Do not move deceased individuals, gear or personal effects except to accomplish rescue work or protect the safety of others. Obtain written documentation of witnesses. Unit Log, ICS 214, may be used for initial documentation, but a narrative will be required.

• As appropriate, conduct an After Action Review to determine successes, areas to improve and lessons learned.
