Discussion: A weak cold front has passed through the fire area, though there is little in the way of colder air moving into the area. Rather than highs around or over 100 degrees, expect afternoon highs more in the lower to middle 90s. Expect at least one more round of scattered showers and storms around the area today, with RH falling to around a 40% minimum. Drier air filters in for Sunday, which will keep afternoon shower development isolated at most, and see minimum relative humidity values in the 25-30% range. Temperatures are also expected to tick up slightly, and likely to reach the middle 90s.

FIRE BEHAVIOR:

Hot and dry conditions today will have all fuels readily available. Fine fuels 1 & 10 hours will be in the 6-7% range. Live fuel moistures are critically low (45-55%) and should be treated as fully cured/dead. These are the fuels that drive the fire. Heavy fuels remain extremely dry. These are the fuels that retain the heat. **KBDI and ERC values still at critical levels.** There is the **potential** for active fire behavior and spread today.

Maximum spotting distance **0.2 miles.**

Peak Probability of Ignition = **52%**

In **15 minutes** a new spot fire or ignition during peak burn conditions in receptive fuels that did not receive rain yesterday could reach **6 acres.**

Specific Areas of Concern:

All Divisions: The diminishing heat due to the extensive mop-up and rains from the last few days have reduced but not eliminated the threat for additional fire movement. Heavy fuels like stumps and logs will continue to hold heat. Dozer berms are still holding heat. Watch areas of needle drop for reburn **potential.** Any lightning outside of yesterday's rain event could produce new ignitions. These could show up even today.

Tiger Island: The hardwood drainage in Division J is an area that needs attention. Check heats identified on the IR.

Hwy 113: The Ten Mile Creek drainage and areas of heat showing on the IR, especially if there is needle/leaf cast.

Elisabeth: The Ten Mile Creek drainage and areas of heat showing on the IR, especially if there is needle/leaf cast.

Lions Camp Road: No areas of extreme concern. Check any identified heat sources from the IR.

Air Operations:

Generally good conditions. Isolated storms in the afternoon may affect air operations.

Fire Behavior Safety Message

Conditions are moderating but not dead. Stay alert for fire inside and outside the containment lines. Have a plan. Always incorporate LCES.

If your guard is down, you may find yourself in deep, of fire coming round.

IWI IC Responsibilities – Division Group Supervisor or Point of Contact

- Take charge of the scene – inform the Division Supervisor and Tiger Island Communications that you are the IWI IC and establish radio communications (frequencies, channels). Identify the emergency name – Division A medical, etc.
- **For backup IWI communication, call the IWI phone: (208) 891-6743.**
- Assign or begin patient assessment (Medical Incident Report - MIR) and first aid. Request additional medical resources on division/branch or across incident. Transmit MIR patient information to Communications.
- Determine patient transportation through consultation with line medical personnel and Medical Unit Leader. Consider transportation time, risk to personnel, destination facility and available operational resources. If air transport is chosen, implement the plan for alternative transportation in the event aircraft cannot complete the mission. Order transportation resources through Communications as early as possible.
- Notify Communications as resources arrive and any patient status changes. Names of injured or deceased individuals will not be transmitted on the radio.
- Initiate documentation for future investigation; if a line safety officer is available, assign them to lead documentation. Do not move deceased individuals, gear or personal effects except to accomplish rescue work or protect the safety of others. Obtain written documentation of witnesses. Unit Log, ICS 214, may be used for initial documentation, but a narrative will be required.
- As appropriate, conduct an After Action Review to determine successes, areas to improve and lessons learned.
