Major Hazards and Risks:

- *Hazard Trees Large areas and numbers of dead trees. Mitigate by identifying & chainsaw felling or staying away. Strong shifting winds associated with thunderstorms can bring these trees down from any direction.
- *Hydration & Fatique Drink at least 16 oz. of water every two hours. To replace electrolytes, mix one part Gatorade (or other sports drink) with two parts water. Set the right pace for the days work ahead. Follow the 2:1 work/rest guidelines.
- *Steep and Rocky Terrain Watch your footing and be aware of rolling rocks. Take your time. Due to remote terrain, a medi-vac could be slow and hazardous. Stay off cliffs.
- *Driving Watch out for the other driver. Drive defensively. Everyone in vehicle will wear seatbelts before vehicle moves every time. Use headlights at all times.
- *Extreme Conditions Maintain LCES and situational awarness. High KDBI's and high fuel loading will result in high flame lengths and rapid rates of spread. Have a plan when conditions indicate a change.

"Talk Like a Pirate" Fire Orders (for fun compare to the corresponding Fire Order)

- 3. Base yer battle plans on whar the fire be and whar ye think it likely to be going.
- 4. AVAST and know the quickest and easiest way to get out o' the fight, and let the rest of the crew know too

- ❖ Do I know what steps to take in a medical emergency?
- ❖ Am I communicating clearly?

- ❖ Do I know who is in charge?
- Current and predicted weather known?
- ❖ Am I wearing all my PPE?
- ❖ Did I ask <u>my</u> questions during the safety briefing?

Escape Route/Safety Zone Checklist

Escape Routes:

- *More than one escape route
- *Scouted soils, vegetation, slope
- *Timed slowest person, fatigue, dozer speed
- *Marked flagged for day and night use

Safety Zones:

- *Survivable without a shelter
- *Natural clean burn, water, bare soil/rock
- *Manmade constructed sites, roads
- *Scouted for size and hazards
- *Close enough considering escape time needed

Remember and Follow:

- *The 10 Standard Fire Orders
- *The 18 Situations That Shout Watch Out
- *The Common Denominators of Fire Behavior on Tragedy Fires
- *The Downhill Line Construction Guidelines
