*Steep and Rocky Terrain - Watch your footing and be aware of rolling rocks. Take your time. Due to remote terrain, a medi-vac could be slow and hazardous. Stay off cliffs.
*Driving - Watch out for the other driver. Drive defensively. Everyone in vehicle will wear seatbelts before vehicle moves every time. Give the weekend warriors plenty of room.
*Complacency - Don't let the low fire activity lull you into complacency. A couple of days of drying can bring this fire back to extreme conditions. Maintain a watchful eye to changing conditions and let others know what you are seeing.
