

# **SAFETY MESSAGE**

# **Major Hazards and Risks:**

**FATIQUE-** Mitigate with 2/1 work rest ratio. Use time off- shift wisely. Eat sensibly and continue to hydrate off duty.

<u>COMMUNICATION</u>- Communication, Communication... It is always critical on any incident. Tailgate Safety Briefings with all crews before moving to the line will be mandatory. Maintain radio communication between personal and divisions should be checked before work shift and when moving to a new division.

<u>DRIVING</u> – Be extra cautious while driving to and from the ICP to the field. Drive defensively. Use passenger as a lookout, navigator, and backing guide. Obey speed limits. Use headlights and seatbelts. 10 MPH in very dusty road conditions. Clean your windows.

<u>**DEMOBILIZATION**</u>- Safety will be emphasized in all phases of the demob process. Remember you are not off the incident till you arrival home safely.

<u>HEAVY EQUIPMENT</u>- Be alert when **heavy equipment is working nearby**, the operators are focused on the task at hand, not necessarily your safety. It is your responsibility to stay clear. Use lookouts as you back. Be aware of unique hazards during winching, protect hands and stay clear of cable. Remain a safe distance from cables under tension, put plenty of trees and distance between you and the cable. Maintain three points of contact while mounting and dismounting equipment.

<u>MULTI AIRCRAFT</u>- Be aware of multi aircraft flying overhead. Pilots will be briefed on strategy and tactics. If aircraft are needed for support, contact your supervisor or his designee's. They will make contact air attack direct on air to ground frequency. **LOOKOUTS, COMMUNICATION, ESCAPE ROUTES, SAFETY ZONES** 

<u>**DEHYDRATION-**</u> Drink often and drink a lot, before you get thirsty. 4:1 water to poweraid or gatorade. Take frequent breaks. It's warm enough to suffer from heat stress during the afternoon. Limit coffee, tea soft drinks, and sports drinks. Water is good for you.

**INSECTS**- Bees, ticks, fire ants are still active. Again; be alert and make others aware.

Accidents: Contact your supervisor and inform him/her. Follow emergency procedures at bottom of medical plan.



# Standard Firefighting Orders

- 1. Keep informed on fire weather conditions and forecast.
- 2. Know what your fire is doing at all times.
- 3. Base all actions on current and expected behavior of the fire.
- 4. Identify escape routes and safety zones and make them known.
- 5. Post lookouts when there is a possible danger.
- 6. Be alert. Keep calm. Think clearly. Act decisively.

- Maintain prompt communications with your forces, your supervisor and adjoining forces.
- 8. Give clear instructions and insure they are understood.
- 9. Maintain control of your forces at all times.
