HEALTH AND SAFETY MESSAGE

INCIDENT: Simmons and Juniper Road Fire	DATE: 7/12/11	TIME: 0730-1900

Major Hazards and Risks:

<u>SNAGS</u>-Stay out of area, essential fire line personnel only, look at root system before working/parking. IRPG pg. 20. <u>DRIVING</u>- Drive defensively. Type 6 engines have high rollover risk and increased stopping distance. Use seatbelts. Vehicle accidents are a major cause for firefighter fatalities. Use headlights on dusty roads. Demobilized units, observe travel restrictions in Demob plan. Safe travel home is part of the assignment.

<u>SCHOOL BUSES-</u> Year- round schools are back in session as well as some summer school programs. Be alert for stopped school buses and children near the highway. Be especially careful traveling around ICP as summer program has started.

MOP-UP- Blouse or close pant legs before entering burned area to prevent burns. Roadbeds can collapse due to ground fire. Learn to identify ash pits from local personnel. Watch for flare-ups.

<u>AIR DROPS</u>- Be alert. Stay out of drop area. Both the approach and departure routes are dangerous to ground personnel. Manage helicopter dip sites to minimize exposure for ground forces. Use Air to Ground channel.

<u>FIRE BEHAVIOR</u> – Maintain situational awareness, follow 10 Standard Orders, recognize / mitigate the 18 Watch Out Situations, and apply LCES. Know the fire weather forecast. Monitor conditions for change.

<u>HYDRATION/HEAT STRESS</u> – Heat index will be 112 @ Simmons Rd. and 110 @ Juniper Rd. today. This is equivalent to working in 110 degree temp. at 20% RH. Be sure to drink plenty of fluids (before you get thirsty), and take frequent breaks. Watch your co-workers for heat related symptoms.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS – Watch for and stay away from rattlesnakes, fire ants and wildlife. Keep all foods secured. Bring all trash off the line. Use insect repellent for ticks. Report tick bites to Medical Unit Leader.

Accidents: Contact your supervisor and inform him/her. Follow emergency procedures at bottom of medical plan. Lightning Activity Level (LAL) 1 through 6. Page 76 in IRPG!

Fuels continue to dry after the rains of last week. Major runs in the bay shrubs and southern rough fuels have been observed. Currently smoldering ground fire has been observed along with active burning in the litter and flare-ups in the shrubs that die back down. The fire has burned actively in green and cured fuels. Torching has been observed with some spotting. Watch for needle/leaf cast on all divisions which will provide surface fuels for smoldering or active ground fire.

Predicted Fire Behavior for Today

Expect an increase in fire behavior today with hot and dry conditions and increased winds.

Forecasted NFDRS indices are up significantly today.

Expect continued smoldering and active fire in organic soils. Active burning will be observed in the timber litter and southern rough fuels on the sand ridges. Ground fire will be the ignition source for cured and green fuels to burn and cause torching. Rates of spread and flame lengths are given for flanking fire and head fire in the table below. Spotting distances and probabilities of ignition are also given. Watch for erratic fire behavior near storms with gusty winds.

The talking points below are for your use in conversations with the media or the public.

- The fire has burned 5,632 acres and is 70 percent contained.
- Recent rain showers did not put the fire out, but slowed the spread of the fire allowing fire fighters time to widen containment lines.
- The improved containment lines should hold as hot, dry conditions return over the next two days.
- Houses along Hwy 53 and Turnbull, Avery and Squatting Bear roads could be threatened if the fire escapes containment lines.
- The NC Forest Service has tractor-plow units, flexTracs and fire engines working to mop up hot spots along the fire perimeter.
- Fire department resources from across the state are in place to provide protection to hundreds of structures around the fire area.
- Air tankers are stationed at the Elizabethtown Airport and helicopters are at Turnbull Creek Educational State Forest to suppress flare ups if needed.
- Ground fire will persist for weeks if the drought continues. Smoke will linger in the area as long as there is ground fire.
- Motorist should use caution in the fire area. Watch for smoke on the highway and slow moving trucks. Poor visibility may be experienced during the early morning hours. Reduce speed accordingly.
- The fire was reported on June 20, 2011 in a Carolina bay near the end on Dennis Harold Simmons Road.
- Wildlife species in the area are accustomed to living in a fire adapted environment and will recover.




