General Control Objectives For The Incident Ensure the safety of firefighers, emergency responders, and general public is our number one priority. We do this through: Strict adherence to the 10 Standard Fire Orders. Mitigating all 18 Watch Out Situations. Implementing LCES (Lookouts, Communications, Escape Routes, and Safetry Zones). **Maintaining Situational Awareness.** Conducting Hazard / Risk Assessments throughout the day. Conduct "tailgate" briefing on the line with an emphasis on personnel safety, health and wellfare. Keep the Simmons Road Fire contained to the following boundaries: East of Hwy 53 North of Live Oak Methodist Church Road **West of Suggs Mill Pond** South of Turnbull Road Continue to improve direct firelines that will provide long term containment and control. Minimize impact to Bushy Lake Natural Area by operating flextracks from within the burned area. Construct in-direct control lines to secure uncontained fire perimeter, and provide contingency lines for possible changing weather conditions and fire behavior and to prepare for possible burnout operations should that be needed in the future. Provide structure protection in conjunction with Cumberland and Bladen EM to residents of Turnbull Rd, Avery Rd and Squatting Bear Road. Monitor fire situation and initiate evacutions should trigger point be breached. 6. Provide a constant flow of accrurate and timely information to local Fire Dept., Emergency Mgmt. citizens and media outlets. Continue rehabilitation works as suppression efforts allow. Identify needs and route thru chain-of-command to SITL. Focus is on mitigating safety hazards and negative impacts to water quality Follow NC Forest Service financial guidelines contained in the Incident Business Manual, to ensure cost effective incident management. Ensure complete documentation for FMAG (Fire Management Assistance Grant). Evaluate resource and staffing needs daily to provide for a smooth and coordinated downsizing toward incident transition. 6. # **HEALTH AND SAFETY MESSAGE**

INCIDENT: Simmons and Juniper Road Fire DATE: 7/14/11 TIME: 0730-1900

### **Major Hazards and Risks:**

**SNAGS**-Stay out of area, essential fire line personnel only, look at root system before working/parking. IRPG pg. 20. **DRIVING**- Drive defensively. Type 6 engines have high rollover risk and increased stopping distance. Use seatbelts. Vehicle accidents are a major cause for firefighter fatalities. Use headlights on dusty roads. Demobilized units, observe travel restrictions in Demob plan. Safe travel home is part of the assignment.

<u>SCHOOL BUSES-</u> Year- round schools are back in session as well as some summer school programs. Be alert for stopped school buses and children near the highway. Be especially careful traveling around ICP as summer program has started.

<u>Personal Hygiene-</u> Practicing good hygiene will prevent the spread of illness and disease. Washing your hands periodically throughout the day will prevent the spread of colds, flu and other ailments. Washing stations will be set up at various places at the staging area. Use them before eating, and after visits to the rest room.

<u>AIR DROPS</u>- Be alert. Stay out of drop area. Both the approach and departure routes are dangerous to ground personnel. Manage helicopter dip sites to minimize exposure for ground forces. Use Air to Ground channel.

FIRE BEHAVIOR – Maintain situational awareness, follow 10 Standard Orders, recognize / mitigate the 18 Watch Out Situations, and apply LCES. Know the fire weather forecast. Monitor conditions for change.

<u>HYDRATION/HEAT STRESS</u> – Heat index will be high again today Be sure to drink plenty of fluids (before you get thirsty), and take frequent breaks. Watch your co-workers for heat related symptoms.

**ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS** – Watch for and stay away from rattlesnakes, fire ants and wildlife. Keep all foods secured. Bring all trash off the line. Use insect repellent for ticks. Report tick bites to Medical Unit Leader.

Accidents: Contact your supervisor and inform him/her. Follow emergency procedures at bottom of medical plan.

**Fuels continue to dry after the rains of last week.** Major runs in the bay shrubs and southern rough fuels have been observed. Currently smoldering ground fire has been observed along with active burning in the litter and flare-ups in the shrubs that die back down. The fire has burned actively in green and cured fuels. Torching has been observed with some spotting. Watch for needle/leaf cast on all divisions which will provide surface fuels for smoldering or active ground fire.

#### **Predicted Fire Behavior for Today**

#### Cooler conditions and higher relative humidity will help with the containment effort today.

IR shows that there is still heat along the perimeter in Juliet, Delta and November. Expect continued smoldering and active fire in organic soils. Ground fire will be the ignition source for cured and green fuels to burn and cause torching and spotting. Active burning will be observed in the timber litter and southern rough fuels on the sand ridges. Rates of spread and flame lengths are given for flanking fire and head fire in the table below. Spotting distances and probabilities of ignition are also given. Watch for erratic fire behavior near storms with gusty winds.

2. Turnbull Road, AB Smith Road, and/or NC Highway 53 - Cumberland County.

Should the fire escape and become established from B11 moving to the north on Divisions P and S.

- 3. Tom Burns Road and/or NC Highway 53 Cumberland County
  Should the fire escape containment lines and become established moving to
  the north from Divisions B and J.
- 4. Simmons Road, Gilbert Edge, Live Oak Church Road, Neighbor Road, and/or Frank Smith Road- Bladen County.

Should the fire escape and become established and moving to the south near Simmons Road and Frank Smith Roads on Divisions A, G, and F.

The talking points below are for your use in conversations with the media or the public.

- The fire has burned 5,632 acres and is 70 percent contained.
- Oppressive heat is an issue with firefighters. Weather readings Wednesday afternoon indicated a heat index of 114 degrees.
- Houses along Hwy 53 and Turnbull, Avery and Squatting Bear roads could be threatened if the fire escapes containment lines.
- The NC Forest Service has tractor-plow units, flextracs and fire engines working to mop up hot spots along the fire perimeter.
- Fire department resources from across the state are in place to provide protection to hundreds of structures around the fire area.


