General Control Objectives For The Incident 1. Ensure the safety of firefighers, emergency responders, and general public is our number one priority. We do this through: Strict adherence to the 10 Standard Fire Orders. Mitigating all 18 Watch Out Situations. Implementing LCES (Lookouts, Communications, Escape Routes, and Safety Zones). **Maintaining Situational Awareness.** Conducting Hazard / Risk Assessments throughout the day. Conduct "tailgate" briefing on the line with an emphasis on personnel safety, health and wellfare. Keep the Simmons Road Fire contained to the following boundaries: East of Hwy 53; North of Live Oak Methodist Church Road; West of Suggs Mill Pond; South of **Turnbull Road** Continue to improve direct firelines that will provide long term containment and control. Minimize impact to Bushy Lake Natural Area by operating flextracks from within the burned area. Mop Up hot spots around fire perimeter identified by Situations UL on Infrared Heat Map. Watch for reburning and flare-up and take appropriate actions as needed. Provide structure protection in conjunction with Cumberland and Bladen EM to residents of Turnbull Rd, Avery Rd and Squatting Bear Road. Monitor fire situation and initiate evacutions should trigger point be breached. Provide a constant flow of accurate and timely information to local Fire Dept., Emergency Mgmt. citizens and media outlets. Continue rehabilitation &/or repair work as suppression efforts allow. Identify needs and route thru chain-ofcommand to SITL. Focus is on mitigating safety hazards and negative impacts to water quality & damage to property. Follow NC Forest Service financial guidelines contained in the Incident Business Manual, to ensure cost effective incident management. Ensure complete documentation for FMAG (Fire Management Assistance Grant). Evaluate resource and staffing needs daily to provide for a smooth and coordinated downsizing toward incident transition. # **HEALTH AND SAFETY MESSAGE**

INCIDENT: Simmons and Juniper Road Fire DATE: 7/19/11 TIME: 0730-1900

#### Major Hazards and Risks:

<u>SNAGS</u>-Stay out of area, essential fire line personnel only, look at root system before working/parking. IRPG pg. 20. <u>Complacency:</u> Remember Situation Awareness Keep focus on objectives, communication, previous fire behavior, weather forecast local factors.

<u>DRIVING</u>- Drive defensively. Backing accidents are common with this type incident. Use spotters when backing and blow your horn to alert personnel of your actions. Use headlights on dusty roads. Observe travel restrictions in Demob plan. Safe travel home is part of the assignment.

<u>Personal Hygiene-</u> Practicing good hygiene will prevent the spread of illness and disease. Washing stations will be set up at various places at the staging area. Use them before eating, and after visits to the rest room.

<u>AIR DROPS</u>- Be alert. Stay out of drop area. Both the approach and departure routes are dangerous to ground personnel. Manage helicopter dip sites to minimize exposure for ground forces. Use Air to Ground channel.

<u>FIRE BEHAVIOR</u> – Maintain situational awareness, follow 10 Standard Orders, recognize / mitigate the 18 Watch Out Situations, and apply LCES. Know the fire weather forecast. Monitor conditions for change.

<u>HYDRATION/HEAT STRESS</u> – Heat index will be high again today Be sure to drink plenty of fluids (before you get thirsty), and take frequent breaks. Watch your co-workers for heat related symptoms.

**ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS** – Watch for and stay away from rattlesnakes, fire ants and wildlife. Keep all foods secured. Bring all trash off the line. Use insect repellent for ticks. Report tick bites to Medical Unit Leader. **TRANSITION**- This is one of the most dangerous times on the fire. Everyone is trying to get oriented on the fire and what is happing on the fire. Be patient get all of your information do not let your counterpart go until you feel you have a handle on your situation.

Accidents: Contact your supervisor and inform him/her. Follow emergency procedures at bottom of medical plan.

<u>General Fire Behavior</u>

Small runs in the bay shrubs and southern rough fuels have been observed. Currently smoldering ground fire has been observed along with active burning in the litter and flare-ups in the shrubs that die back down. The fire has burned actively in green and cured fuels. Torching has been observed with some spotting. Watch for needle/leaf cast on ALL divisions which will provide surface fuels for smoldering or active ground fire.

#### **Specific Fire Behavior**

#### Expect different areas of the fire to show activity now that the fire is getting a different general wind direction.

Organic soils continue to dry. Fire hawk IR data shows that the ground fire is spreading in bays 1, 2, and 11. The fire will become active earlier than it has in the previous days. Expect continued smoldering and active fire in the organic soils. Ground fire will be the ignition source for cured and green fuels to burn and cause torching and spotting. Expect reburn in areas with heavy needle cast and smoldering ground fire.


