HEALTH AND SAFETY MESSAGE

INCIDENT: NCFS Summer 24 Fire Support

DATE: 06/22/24 **OPERATIONAL PERIOD:** 0700-1900

Major Hazards and Risks:

• EXCESSIVE HEAT & HUMIDITY

- With Temperatures reaching the mid 90's and Relative Humidity's near the 50% range, hazardous conditions to fire fighters will exist in terms of heat related illness. Make sure to drink plenty of clear fluids. At a minimum fire fighters should drink between 24 oz. and 32 oz. of water per hour. Limit the amount of sports drink intake & refrain from drinking soda as much as possible to avoid becoming dehydrated. Drink 3 bottles of water for every one bottle of sports drink.
- In addition to drinking plenty of fluids, fire fighters should take at least one 10-minute break every 2 hours at a minimum in a shaded or air conditioned area. The hotter that it gets, personnel should take longer and more frequent breaks to avoid heat related illness.
- Review the symptoms of heat stress with all personnel during morning briefings.

DRIVING HAZARDS

- Drive defensively. Use passengers to watch out for hazards along the road or fireline.
- Avoid talking or texting on your cell phones while driving. Pull off on the side of the road in a safe location to make phone calls. Avoid side conversations with others while driving. Concentrate on the road.
- Watch for animals, other distracted drivers, pedestrians, and other hazards on the road that may jump into your lane of travel. Give yourself plenty of space between other vehicles and always look for an escape route.

EXPERIENCE OF PERSONNEL

• Know your limitations and the limitations of those who may work for you. There may be a large number of fire fighters on your fire that do not have a lot of experience. Make sure to take care of your people and give a good safety briefing before beginning operations. Make everyone aware of all hazards and mitigations. Don't assume that everyone sees the danger.


