Narrative:

- ID and make others aware snags. Fall snags that are near the fire line when possible. Be careful around blowdown debris from Hurricane. It will be slow getting through the debris.
- Stay Hydrated. Dehydration can sneak up on you.
- Watch footing and take your time.
- Keep good Situational Awareness.
- Watch for power lines and propane tanks near houses.
- Obey speed limits and watch out for motorist.
- Maintain constant communication.
- Don't let complacency creep in.
- Each Fire Fighter is their own Safety Officer. Keep an eye out for issues and report them. See something, say something.
- Be aware of aircraft working in your area.
- Keep areas clear as chainsaw operators and swampers clear downed debris.
- Maintain high visibility, use headlamps, take breaks away from hazards, watch for fatigue.
