WEATHER DISCUSSION:

The high pressure system will move over the Gulf of Mexico and cause a moist southeast flow to become entrenched over central and eastern Texas later today through early Sunday. The relative humidity will increase a little this afternoon and then rapidly on Friday night through Saturday. Low stratus deck and/or fog may occur over western half of the area. The combination of increased moisture at low levels and cooling temperatures aloft will create a slightly unstable environment by Saturday afternoon across Linden and Henderson zones...especially western portions for a chance of showers. A weak cold trough will slide southeast across northeast Texas Saturday night into early Sunday (Linden and Henderson Zones) and across southeast Texas (Livingston and Woodville Zones) Sunday. Scattered showers and thunderstorms are likely during this period producing upwards to 0.50 of an inch towards Texarkana, but less than 0.25 of an inch will be more common for Linden and Henderson and less than 0.10 of an inch south of Lufkin.

TODAY/TONIGHT for NORTH – Linden Dispatch Zone:

WEATHER: Mostly sunny. Partly cloudy tonight.

MAX TEMPS: 74-80 / MIN TEMPS: 54-60.

MIN RH: 28-33% eastern areas to 40% western areas. MAX RH: 70-85%. Good to excellent recovery.

WINDS: South southeast 7-10 mph gusts 13 mph extreme west.

HAINES INDEX: 4 MIXING HEIGHT: 6200 ft.

OUTLOOK: SATURDAY

Mostly cloudy. Slight chance of showers. Highs 74-78. Min RH 46-56%. SSE 6-9 mph G14 mph.

FUEL ASSUMPTIONS: The major fuel types found in the SE Texas Complex are fuel model TU3 (moderate timber understory), Fire Behavior Prediction System Fuel model 9 and grass fuel model 1. High risk fuels include pine plantations and southern rough brush with yaupon underneath a mature pine canopy. Young pine plantations may react similar to a brush model due to low live fuel moistures. There are also areas with slash from logging operations.

WEATHER SUMMARY: As the high pressure system moves over the Gulf, moist southeast flow will cover the area late today through Sunday. Higher minimum RHs (28-34%, with some areas not getting below 40%) and winds of 7-10 gusts of 12 mph, with temps 74-80° across the north and 78-82° towards the south. Good RH recovery at Friday night (70% and higher). Saturday we could have, in late afternoon, some rain /thunderstorms in Linden and Henderson Zones.

SE Texas Complex General Fire Behavior Forecast: Drought condition still persist across the zone. Live fuel moistures continue to be extremely low making the live scrubs and trees available to burn. Be very cautious when critical fire behavior thresholds are exceeded. When thresholds are exceeded fires will become very resistant to control with ground resources and will require the combination of aerial and ground resources to be effective in controlling fires.

**Critical fire behavior thresholds: (Temp >90°, RH < 30%, Winds > 10 mph).
RH and Wind thresholds are borderline for being met.**

Specific:

Linden, Henderson, Livingston and Woodville Dispatch Zones

Grass fuels are cured and will support high rates of spread. High risk fuels include pine plantations and southern rough brush with yaupon underneath a mature pine canopy. Fire will easily spread into the canopy when latter fuels are present; expect long range spotting when this occurs.

One hour fine dead fuel moisture will drop to 6% with isolated areas of 5% in Linden Zone. 100 & 1000 hour fuels are ranging 13 to 18%. KBDI 650-780 with 1/2 of the area over 700. Extensive mop up is required.

Most spotting is well less than 100 feet.

Forecasted ERC Friday: Linden ERC 47 (90%-37/97%-40), Conroe ERC 36 (90%-34/97%-38)

AIR OPERATIONS: No weather issues anticipated. (Sat – expect some fog/low clouds in the morning)

FIRE BEHAVIOR SAFETY: Don't get complacent. Pay attention to what the fuels are where the fire is burning and what changes are ahead. Remember to watch for oil & gas lines as well as power lines.

Check the Demob list in the IAP. Verify with your supervisor that your TRAVEL DAY is correct. If not, coordinate with the DEMOB UNIT. Five days prior to your TRAVEL DAY, submit the completed "Air Travel Request" (ATR) to the DEMOB UNIT in person or by FAX (936-632-1372). The ATR is provided in the IAPs or through the DEMOB UNIT. Be sure to provide personal contact information on the ATR so that the DEMOB UNIT can call in order to give you your flight arrangements. It is expensive and time consuming to change flight arrangements once they have been made, so make sure to provide the correct information on the ATR.

IMPORTANT SHUTTLE INFORMATION

Airport shuttle from the ICP leaves at 0800 and 1800.

If your flight departs before Noon on your travel day, you **MUST** start your DEMOB PROCESS by 1600 on your last work day (the day before your travel day). You will then be transported by the 1800 airport shuttle to a motel in the vicinity of the airport, where you will rest overnight.

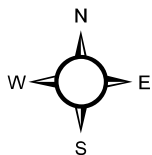

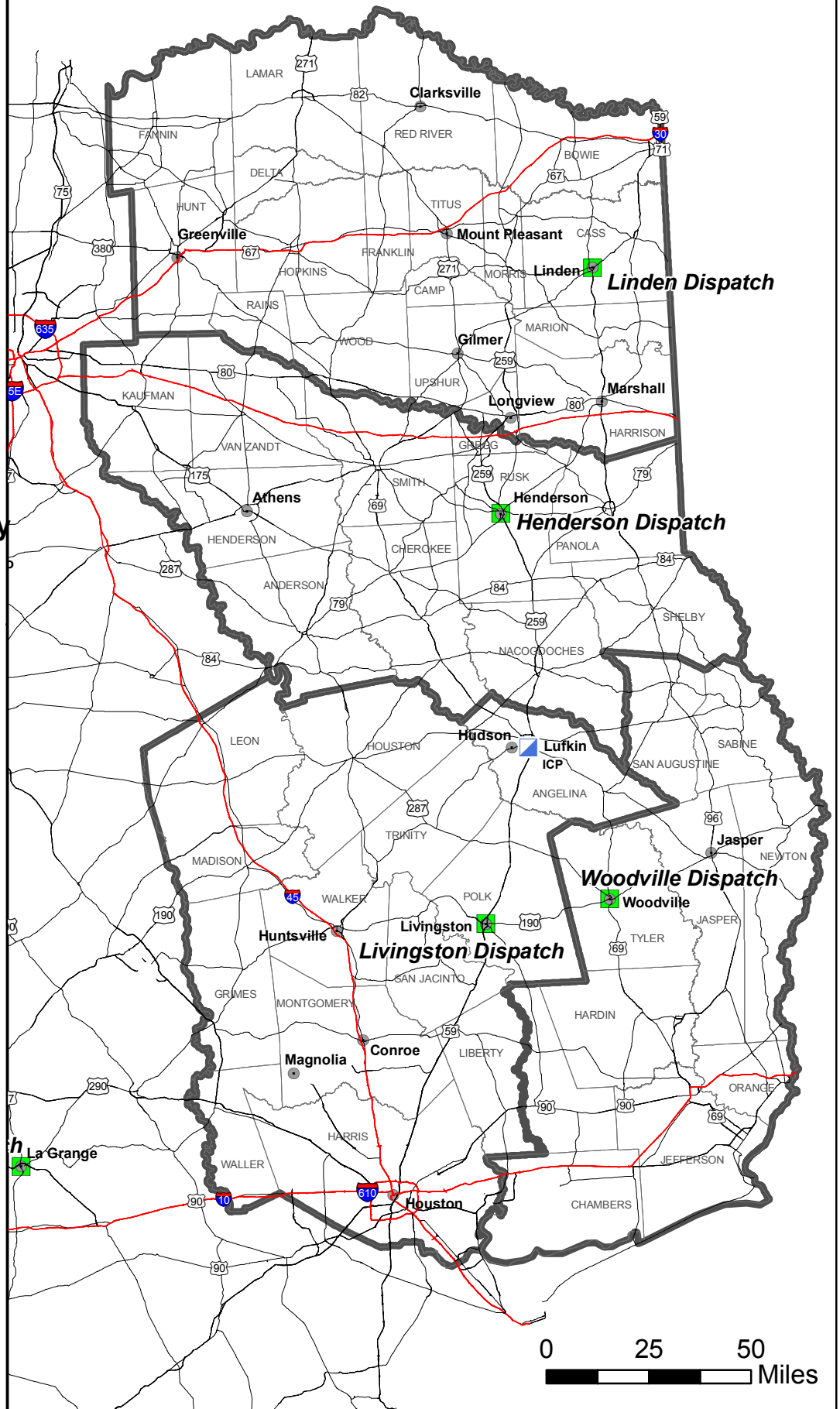
