WEATHER DISCUSSION:COLD FRONTAL PASSAGE TODAY...

A cold front will be located along a SE Linden to NW Henderson line at shift start time. The front is expected to reach NW Livingston zone by early afternoon, pass through Lufkin ICP mid-afternoon, and finally reach southern Livingston and Woodville zones near end of shift. Shower activity will increase over Linden zone shortly before sunrise. Precipitation will gradually spread south throughout the day. Isolated thunderstorms can be expected as well. Highest rainfall amounts should be over Linden and Eastern Henderson zones. It will be much cooler today over the northern two-thirds of the area. Precipitation will continue over the south and east Thursday night, then end by midday Friday. High temperatures Friday will be up to 20 degrees cooler than readings early this week. Dry conditions should continue through the weekend and early next week.

<u>TODAY/TONIGHT for NORTH – Linden Dispatch Zone:</u>

WEATHER: Showers and isolated thunderstorms in the morning then rain. Rainfall amounts 0.40 to 0.80 inches.

MAX TEMPS: 53-63 / **MIN TEMPS**: 41-48.

MIN RH: 65-80% MAX RH: Above 90%. Excellent recovery.

WINDS: North 8-14 mph with gusts to 22 mph. Wind easing to 4-9 mph after 1800.

HAINES INDEX: 3. MIXING HEIGHT: 1500-2000 ft.

OUTLOOK: FRIDAY

Mostly cloudy in the morning with a chance of showers. Partly cloudy in the afternoon. Highs 58-66. Min RH 35-45%. North to Northeast wind 3-8 mph in the morning then 6-11 mph. Afternoon gusts to 18 mph.

<u>TODAY/TONIGHT for CENTRAL – Henderson Dispatch Zone:</u>

WEATHER: Scattered showers and a slight chance of thunderstorms in the morning. Showers and a chance of

thunderstorms in the afternoon. Rainfall amounts 0.15 to 0.40, highest northwest.

MAX TEMPS: 63-75 warmest far south / **MIN TEMPS**: 46-52.

MIN RH: 60-75%. MAX RH: Above 90%. Excellent recovery.

WINDS: Southwest to West 5-10 mph. Wind becoming Northwest to North 7-13 mph in the afternoon with gusts

OUTLOOK: FRIDAY

Scattered morning showers then partly cloudy. Highs in the 60s. Min RH 40-55%, highest east. North wind 6-11 mph with gusts up to 18 mph.

TODAY/TONIGHT for SOUTH – Livingston/Woodville Dispatch Zone:

WEATHER: Mostly cloudy with a chance of showers and a slight chance of thunderstorms. Scattered showers

developing in the north mid to late afternoon. Rainfall amounts 0.15 northwest to zero southeast.

MAX TEMPS: 74-81 warmest far south / MIN TEMPS: 47-55

MIN RH: 55-70% / MAX RH: Above 90%. Good to Excellent recovery.

WINDS: South to Southwest 5-10 mph. Wind becoming Northwest to North 6-12 mph late in the day.

HAINES INDEX: 3-4 MIXING HEIGHT: 2500-3500 ft.

OUTLOOK: FRIDAY

Scattered morning showers then partly sunny. Highs in the 60s. Min RH 50-65%, but 40s far Northwest. North wind 8-15 mph with gusts 20-25 mph.

FUEL ASSUMPTIONS: The major fuel types found in the SE Texas Complex are fuel model <u>TU3</u> (moderate timber understory), Fire Behavior Prediction System Fuel model 9 and grass fuel model 1. High risk fuels include pine plantations and southern rough brush with yaupon underneath a mature pine canopy. Young pine plantations may react similar to a brush model due to low live fuel moistures. There are also areas with slash from logging operations.

WEATHER SUMMARY: **Also refer to Weather Forecast**: Frontal passage today – rain ahead of the front and trailing behind it allows for amounts as much as 0.4 - 0.8" in Linden diminishing to 0 - 0.15" in the South. Friday chance for Precip. in morning and RH 10-25% less than yesterday.

SE Texas Complex General Fire Behavior Forecast: Drought condition still persist across the zone. Live fuel moistures continue to be extremely low making the live scrubs and trees available to burn. Be very cautious when critical fire behavior thresholds are exceeded. When thresholds are exceeded fires will become very resistant to control with ground resources and will require the combination of aerial and ground resources to be effective in controlling fires.

<u>Critical fire behavior thresholds:</u> (Temp >90°, RH < 30%, Winds > 10 mph). Threshold for Winds met in all zones

Specific:

Linden, Henderson, Livingston and Woodville Dispatch Zones

Grass fuels are cured and will support high rates of spread. High risk fuels include pine plantations and southern rough brush with yaupon underneath a mature pine canopy. Fire will easily spread into the canopy when latter fuels are present; expect long range spotting when this occurs.

The above table reflects ZERO rainfall with only cloud cover and RH effects on fuels. As rain occurs values move towards zero in all fuels.

Prior to rain occurring the rise in RH will dampen potential of new starts way down. Once rain occurs potential of spread diminishes greatly once area receives 0.05" of rain.

The far south will have drier fuels into later in the day, so should a fire occur vicinity of HWY 105 or US 90 and southward, it could burn slightly better than table shows above.

One hour fine dead fuel moisture might get down to 13% in north & 12% in the south. 100 & 1000 hour fuels are ranging 13 to 19%. KBDI range: 450 (2 counties) - 730, with only 10 counties over 700; Most of the counties are above 575.

Weather will work with most mop-up needs except in heavies, and the duff layer as you move south. Most spotting today will be less than 10 feet, but could get under rare circumstances up to predicted.

ERCs remain near 90th percentile. Forecasted ERC: Linden ERC 29 (90%-37/97%-40), Conroe ERC 28 (90%-34/97%-38)

AIR OPERATIONS: Low clouds, thunderstorms, wind gusts.

FIRE BEHAVIOR SAFETY: Thunderstorm Safety practices. Muddy conditions on fire lines.

Communications: As the transition takes place, the need to effectively communicate on the fire is important. Take personal responsibility to ensure that people you interact with know what they need to know. Transition brings new faces and different ways of communicating. Make it work.

DEMOB PROCEDURES FOR THOSE THAT TRAVEL BY AIR

Check the Demob list in the IAP. Verify with your supervisor that your TRAVEL DAY is correct. If not, coordinate with the DEMOB UNIT. Five days prior to your TRAVEL DAY, submit the completed "Air Travel Request" (ATR) to the DEMOB UNIT in person or by FAX (936-632-1372). The ATR is provided in the IAPs or through the DEMOB UNIT. Be sure to provide personal contact information on the ATR so that the DEMOB UNIT can call in order to give you your flight arrangements. It is expensive and time consuming to change flight arrangements once they have been made, so make sure to provide the correct information on the ATR.

IMPORTANT SHUTTLE INFORMATION

Airport shuttle from the ICP leaves at 0800 and 1800.

If your flight departs before Noon on your travel day, you MUST start your DEMOB PROCESS by 1600 on your last work day (the day before your travel day). You will then be transported by the 1800 airport shuttle to a motel in the vicinity of the airport, where you will rest overnight. The motel will provide you a ride to the airport the next morning. You should arrange to be at the airport two hours in advance of your departure time.

If your flight departs after Noon on your travel day, you should start your demob process the evening of your last work day. The next morning, the 0800 airport shuttle will deliver you to the airport in time for your departure flight.




