Elevated fire weather concerns will return on Wednesday and again through the weekend. Warm temperatures in the 70s and 80s accompanied by sustained wind speeds of 15-25 mph and gusts upwards of 30 mph possible, and RH values in the mid-teens up to 30% will allow for the return of elevated fire weather concerns generally along and west of I-35. Otherwise, the cooler temperatures on Thursday and the slower winds on Saturday will mitigate the fire weather concerns somewhat.

Know what your agency policy: Single resource driving limit 10 hours behind the wheel (BIA 8 hours), multiple drivers may drive up to duty driving limits with No one driver behind the wheel more than 10 hours. Take plenty of breaks at least every 2 hours.
