





Fire Behavior Discussion - ALL DIVISIONS

The smoldering fire but will continue to burn down into the ground, however surface spread will slow for a few days. Fire will continue burning the heavy fuels (logs) because they will not be affected by the moisture, Watch for possible spreading and increased intensity if fire advances into any of the cut over or blow down units.

Low Brush/Regeneration/ Slash (Models 4,6,12) - ROS: < 7 chains / hr FL: 5-8 feet Spotting Distance 0.1 miles POI 15% (DIV - ALL)

Hardwood with Understory (Model 10) - ROS: < 4 chains / hr FL: < 2 feet Spotting Distance 0.1 miles POI 15% (DIV ALL)

Southern Rough (Brush with Overstory) (Model SH9) - ROS: <15 chains / hr FL: 5-6 feet Spotting Distance 0.1 miles POI 15% (DIV B, C, Bull North)

Major Hazards and Risks:

Communications – When you know something the first question you should ask yourself is who else needs to know about this? Share information related to the fire up and down the fire line, as well as with your adjoining forces. Follow the IAP communication plan.

Snags – Use lookouts to cover work areas 360 degrees. Don't park vehicles within falling distance of hazardous trees. Snags can "kill" and we have been fortunate so far that no accidents or injuries have occurred with the number of trees reported falling. As the fire continues to burn around the base and weaken trees this is a situation we cannot afford to become complacent about.

Heavy Equipment – The complexity of this incident is still increasing. There is a lot of heavy equipment online increasing the amount of hazards. Parking congestion, material being thrown from cutting equipment, operator visibility, and equipment noise are all factors to be thinking about when working near heavy equipment.

Road Conditions – Rain has changed the road conditions as fire line traffic uses them. The gravel roads will support traffic in wet conditions, the unsurfaced roads are turning to mud making travel difficult. Know your route will support the vehicle you are driving before you decide to take it. Follow the preferred travel routes shown in the IAP.
