Proceed on foot east and north on the farm road to the bridge across intercoastal waterway to State Route 17 for pick up.

Use PPE appropriate for the job you are performing and change as your task changes. Watch out for wildlife...just because nothing was present an hour ago doesn't mean that hasn't changed. Cases of Poison Ivy in the medical unit are numerous. Change your nomex daily to minimize the risk if you are susceptible to it.

**Snags** – Fallers must have a clear safety zone as they take trees down. They may need to interrupt operations for short periods and ask you to disconnect hoses, move vehicles, etc. to take snags down but it has to be done. Please cooperate with fallers to make the area you are working in safer.

**Heavy Equipment** – There are a lot of moving parts to this incident. There is a lot of heavy equipment on-line increasing the amount of hazards. Parking congestion, material being thrown from cutting equipment, operator field of vision, and equipment noise are all factors to be thinking about when working near heavy equipment.

**Road Maintenance** – The road maintenance work is beginning. Think about this question...Am I parked in a good place so I don't impeded someone else's work. If the answer is no.....you need to find a better location for your vehicle/equipment.




