Proceed on foot east and north on the farm road to the bridge across intercoastal waterway to State Route 17 for pick up.







Watch for hot fuel pockets and any stump, root, or peat holes if walking in the black or along the road shoulders.

Watch for possible dense Fog for the early morning drive.

**Fatigue** – Take full advantage of off duty time to get needed rest. The 2 to 1 work/rest ratio is for every person assigned to the incident. If you do have to work past this ratio be sure to mitigate by starting later the next shift thus allowing for adequate time off for rest.
