Improve fire line between Corapeake and South Ditch

Fire along West Ditch between DP2 and DP3 as needed.

Excavator will be used to clean ditch between DP2 and DP3.

Remove downed trees from South Ditch Road and Riddick Road when resources become available.

Use aviation resources as needed.







## Fire Behavior Discussion - ALL DIVISIONS: WIND INCREASING FROM THE SW TODAY

Watch for the winds to switch to the SW and increase as the day progresses. The winds could push the ground fire along the east perimeter and cause the down trees to flair-up (SEE: Low Brush and Hardwood Understory). POI in the receptive fuels is 70+ %. Watch for spotting if the heavy fuels begin to burn. Ground fire and surface fuels could increase in intensity. Watch for possible increased intensity if the fire advances into any of the cut over or blow down units north of Bull North and along the east along the Corapeake Ditch (SEE: Southern Rough).

<u>Low Brush/Regeneration/ Slash</u> (Models 4,6,12) – ROS: < 40 chains / hr FL: 8-11 feet Spotting Distance 0.1 miles POI 70% (DIV - ALL)

<u>Hardwood with Understory</u> (Model 10) – ROS: < 1/2/ to 1 chain / hr FL: < 2 feet Spotting Distance 0.1 miles POI 70% (DIV ALL)

**Southern Rough (Brush with Overstory)** (Model SH9) – ROS: 30-40 chains / hr FL: 12-16 feet Spotting Distance 0.1 miles POI 70% (DIV B, C, Bull North)

Keep informed on fire weather conditions and forecasts.

Know what your fire is doing at all times.

Base all actions on current and expected behavior of the fire.

Wind increases and/or changes direction

**Road Congestion** – Drop points, Intersections and Parking Areas are still areas of high concern for accidents. There is a lot of traffic on Corapeak Ditch and West Ditch road as they are the main arteries into the fire. Slow to **5 MPH** when going past personnel or equipment on the roads in the Refuge. You never know when someone may step out from behind equipment. This kind of accident is preventable if you are focused on driving and not thinking about what you need to do when you arrive at your destination.

**Road Shoulders** – With the rising water levels in the ditches the road shoulders could become soft. Park on the opposite side of the road from the ditches if possible. Fire and road travel have weakened the edges of the road.

Strong and Gusty Wind Conditions – Watch for falling trees as wind gusts push fire-weakened trees or rootsprung trees over into fire lines and roads. Winds may also cause an increase in fire behavior, especially where trees have fallen and cured over the past few days. Spotting potential will increase.

Travel to and from ICP and the fire – Listen to fog warnings and prepare to seek a safe area and stop if super fog is encountered. Contact ICP and let them know your location. Stick to the designated travel routes when travelling to ICP and the incident. (Stay off the narrow and winding roads.)


**Tractor and Plow Safety:** Keep back safe distance from tractors plowing and pushing. Apply safe winching techniques when getting unstuck and keep all personnel away from winch cable.
