.DISCUSSION...Moisture is spreading in from the south on schedule, with showers and thunderstorms south of the wildfire area this afternoon. A light shower is possible overnight with some debris cloud leftover from earlier convection. Thunderstorm chances will increase Thursday. Strong and erratic outflows with storms. Brief heavy rain with relatively tight storm cores.
