Leader's Intent

Provide the highest level of customer service to all involved with or impacted by the Hermits Peak and Calf Canyon Fires. Ensure transparent, timely and accurate communication at all levels of the incident and strengthen relationships with cooperators and landowners. All incident assigned personnel should be prepared to take appropriate actions regarding:

- Professional behavior, conduct, and timely/effective communication.
- Personal safety and the safety of others, including driving slowly and defensively.
- Manage fatigue by taking breaks and maintaining work/rest cycles.
- Minimize risk and limit exposure to infectious disease through coordination and alignment with the state of New Mexico and local County Health Departments.

Incident Objectives

- Provide for firefighter and public safety through hazard recognition and application of the risk management process.
- Coordinate with agency administrators, Incident Management Teams assigned to the fire, and Strategic Operational Planning.
- Coordinate suppression activities with assigned incident Resource Advisors, State of New Mexico Representatives and Tribal Advisors to minimize impacts to wilderness, natural and cultural resources.
- Protect at-risk values to avoid loss or damage of communities, private inholdings, infrastructure, range assets, wildlife, and watersheds.

Operational Objectives

- Develop a strategy that minimizes fire impacts to residences, commercial properties, and critical community infrastructure that reduces the potential for adverse health, social, financial, and economic hardships.
- Coordinate and share incident assigned resources.

To prevent the fire from spreading to private property, surrounding communities, and values at risk, keep the fire:

- East of Hwy 434.
- Within perimeter of the East Zone to limit fire growth.

FIRE BEHAVIOR OUTPUTS

GENERAL: Main fire progression will continue to be in the West Zone to the north and east. Minimal to no forward fire spread expected in the East Zone. Make sure lookouts have a good view of the fire were areas of interior smokes are visible and there is a continuous canopy. Past fire history has shown reburn through the crowns and with the winds the potential for reburn is high. Expect the fire to become very active after 1400hrs. and continue through the evening until the winds subside.

If fire were to become established, outside the lines or you are supporting IA. Expect moderate rates of spread single and group tree torching and short range spotting 400ft.

If afternoon thunderstorms develop keep eyes out for new starts and expect dramatic changes in wind speeds and direction.

Night no forward progression is expected.

1000hr fuels are at 6%FM and are receptive to spots

Probability of Ignition 90-100%

SPECIFIC:

DIV YY: No forward fire progression expected. Keep a heads up for hold over heat that could be a source of spotting. **DIV VV:** No forward progression is expected. There are still sources of heat near the perimeter. Rollout will be the biggest potential for fire getting across the line. Any fire established outside the lines will burn back towards the black or flank run below the black.

DIV TT, OO, LL: The fire is not expected to affect these three Divisions during this operational period.

AIR OPERATIONS: Minimal smoke impacts to air operations. Afternoon thunderstorms have the potential to shut down air operations.

SAFETY

Most of the fire is situated on extremely steep slopes assess your work area for rollout potential.

Major Hazards and Risks:

- > ENTRAPMENT: Focus on Risk Management. Establish LCES prior to engagement
- > FIRE BEHAVIOR, FIRE WEATHER: Participate in briefings, gather situational awareness
- > MEDICAL EMERGENCIES (IWI): Identify resources on East Zone
- > COMMUNICATIONS: Know where weak spots are
- Entrapment Avoidance: Recognize tactical challenges and hazards. Become familiar with topographic features and conditions. Maintain Lookouts, Communications, Escape Routes, and Safety Zones LCES, and update as needed. There is Wildland Urban Interface throughout, realize some roads are very narrow with challenging ingress and egress. Know bridge load limits and remember "Safety First."
- **Fire Behavior:** Remember; Base all actions on current and expected fire behavior. Obtain weather forecast and stay alert to changing conditions.
- Incident Within Incident (IWI): Know the Medical Emergency Procedures and review the Medical Incident Report located in the IAP, Medical Plan, ICS 206.
- **Briefings:** Obtain thorough briefings and maps. Maintain positive communications, know your assigned location, who to report to, and adjoining forces. Understand your mission and risk management process.

Be Accountable

- Adaptability and Positive Attitude: Leads to a safer environment. Allow yourself and adjoining forces to safely adjust while meeting incident and operational objectives
- Assess the Situation: Maintain Situational Awareness, look for hazards, communicate them, and mitigate using sound risk management processes
- *Transition:* When transitions occur, there is always a high potential for unintended outcomes. Be proactive in mitigating risks. Know Leaders Intent. Become familiar with geographical locations, adjoining forces, and new folks you will be working with.




