<b>Comments /notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation:</b> Initial perimeter pulled from NIFS Daily Wildfire Perimeter at 07/19/2024 – 0100 MDT Scattered heat along much of the perimeter, including the east boundary road as control line. Small pocket of scattered heat outside of the main perimeter along the southern road as control line, between drop points 64 and 62. Control lines appear to be holding. The majority of the interior is no longer showing heat.
