Statement:	Meaning:	Example: ENG332 is stationed at Pinecrest
In Service:	Wheels moving to specific area	ENG332 in service to Dry Meadow
In service local:	Wheels moving in local area patrolling	ENG332 in service local
Available:	Available at a location (not duty station)	ENG332 available Brightman
Available quarters:	Available at duty station	ENG332 in quarters Pinecrest
In quarters:	At duty station	ENG332 in quarters Pinecrest
In service delay:	In service on a delay	ENG332 in service to Hull Creek for PT
Available delay:	Avail on a delay	ENG332 avail delay for PT
In service unavail:	Wheels moving but not able to respond	ENG332 in service unavail to the equipment shop for maintenance
Available cell:	Not listening to radio, call cell	ENG332 in Sonora available by cell
Out of service:	End of day, going home	ENG332 out of service

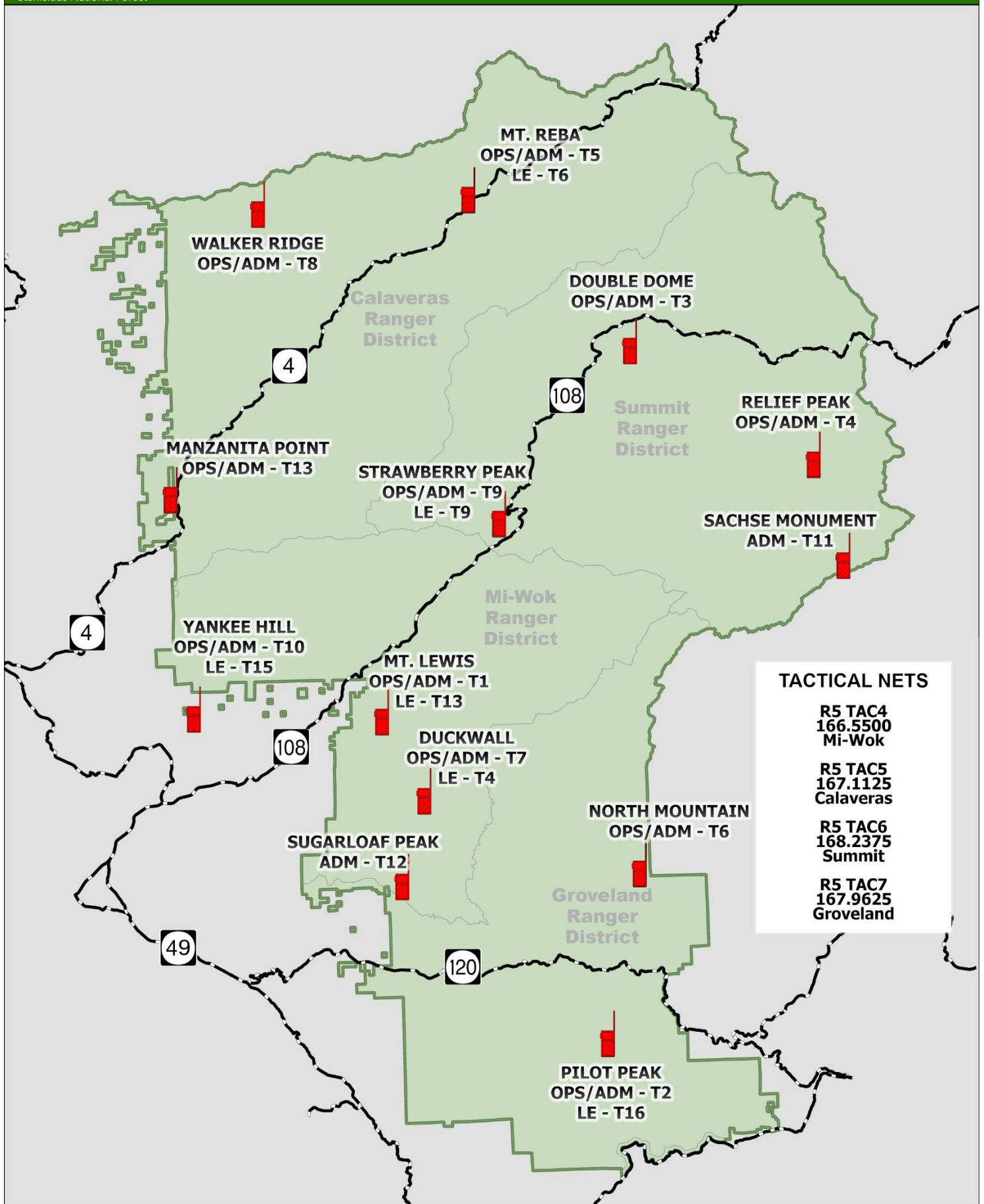
D51/D53	Tone 1 and 7 Sonora to Long Barn
Sugar Pine- (HWY 108)	Tone 9 Pinecrest to Dry Meadow Tone 3 Donnell Vista to top of pass (Tone 5 is some locations)
D52 Calaveras- (HWY 4)	Tone 10 and 13 Columbia to Dorrington Tone 13 and 5 Dorrington to top of pass
D54 Groveland- (HWY 120)	Tone 7 and 2 Sonora to Groveland Tone 6 Cherry Lake
